Saint Frances Cabrini School K3-8th Grade Registration and Tuition Payment Contract 2023-2024

Please complete all forms that are attached and return to the office by April 30th. In addition to filling out and signing the attached forms please go onto Pro-Care and register for the school year online. Registration implies the responsibility to cooperate with the policies of the Saint Frances Cabrini School Committee and Administration, and the guidelines of the Parish Council. If you have any questions regarding these policies, please contact the principal before finalizing your registration. NOTE: If your child is new to SFC and entering grade K5 or higher, the student will be temporarily placed until we receive documentation from a prior school attended to determine actual classroom placement.

If a limited number of spaces exist at a grade level, then priority for enrollment will be given as follows:

- 1. Registered Parishioners with children in school including current K3.
- Registered Parishioners without children in school.
- 3. Non-parishioners with children in school.
- 4. Non-parishioners without children in school.

All families ending the 2022-2023 school year (by June 30th) with an unpaid balance and without an approved payment plan should contact Chris Chlebek at the parish office before enrolling.

Education Fund Tuition Assistance

Through the generosity of school families, parish members, and those in our community and beyond, we have a tuition assistance program available to help families who otherwise might not be able to afford all tuition cost. Applications are available in the school office (See below for more information)

Registration Fee

There is a Registration Fee of \$150 per student, with a maximum of \$450 per family, which MUST be included with this registration form in order to hold your place for next year. *After April 30th, the Registration Fee is \$200 per student.* (If you decide to withdraw by July 1st your money will be refunded.)

Referral Tuition Credit

The purpose of this program is to reward current St Frances Cabrini families a credit of \$500 to be applied towards their tuition for successfully referring a family of a newly enrolled student. In an effort to increase and sustain enrollment at St Frances Cabrini. Contact the school office for more information.

Educational Fund Financial Assistance

Education Fund grants are available for students attending Full Day K3 through 8th grade. An Education Fund Grant Application must be completed in order to qualify for the grant. Our purpose is to ensure a fair and equitable distribution of grant funds to families via a process that maintains the privacy of applicants and awards the grants based on basic standards of need, asset and income levels, and parish community involvement. Applications are reviewed by the Parish Finance Council **If you are interested in assistance please contact the principal for the proper forms or check the website under the registration tab.

Before and After School Care

We offer before school care for students starting at 6:30a.m and going until 7:30a.m. We also provide after school care starting at 2:50p.m. and ending at 5:00p.m. If you plan on utilizing this service please indicate on the Enrollment/Re-Enrollment form.

Commitment to Adult and Family Faith Formation: SFC Rooted Program

An essential component of our school's Exemplary Status in the area of Catholic Identity and Mission is our two-fold educational outreach in the area of faith formation to parents and students together.

At Saint Frances Cabrini School, we are committed to educating both students as well as parents in the teachings of the Catholic Church. Faith formation does not occur only in a classroom. Faith formation is a shared partnership between parents, students, the parish staff, the parish community, our priests, and our teachers.

In an effort to assist you as the primary educators of your child the parish offers the Rooted program to you, at no cost!

Rooted is the parish's family faith formation program that is held monthly during the school year. It consists of faith formation activities and lessons for parents alone, for children alone, and also for parents together with their children. The adult education portions are taught by our priests. The sessions are offered on a Sunday morning and are repeated on a Wednesday evening; you may come to either as a family.

It is the parish and school's recommendation to take advantage of this opportunity. If Rooted does not work with your family schedule, you are highly encouraged to utilize other adult and family faith education resources that the parish makes available (for example: Formed.org). We are happy to offer additional resources to you as well upon request.

Participation and registration in the Rooted Program is **free** of charge for our families enrolled in our day school.

Registration materials for Rooted will be sent to your family this spring. Parents/ families who are not Catholic are also welcome to attend Rooted free of charge, if you discern it is appropriate for your family to do so in light of your specific faith background.

As a condition of my child/children's enrollment at Saint Frances Cabrini Parish School, <u>lagree</u>:

- For Catholics: to learn my faith on an adult level by engaging in ongoing formation, and to practice my faith according to the precepts and teachings of the Gospel and of the Catholic Church to the best of my ability, including attending Sunday Mass regularly, celebrating the Sacrament of Confession habitually, and supporting the mission of the Church with my financial and personal resources, including regularly volunteering my time to support parish ministries.
- For non-Catholics: to live a life of virtue; and I understand that no compromises on Church teachings, or on Catholic practices and customs will occur in our school environment, and that non-Catholics will be expected to attend school Masses and devotional services, participating to the limits allowed by the teachings of the Church.
- To attend a Safeguarding God's Children class (all parents and any volunteers must complete this class once)
