



- Fruit and/or Veggie




Our current total is 422 calendars sold!

DEFINITION OF COURTESY:

Treating other people with respect; recognizing that all are made in God's image and likeness

The opposite of showing courtesy to others is not recognizing the inherent dignity of others made in God's image and likeness.

COURTESY LOOKS LIKE:

- Letting others go first
- Practicing your manners
- Showing an awareness of the feelings of others around you

COURTESY SOUNDS LIKE:

- "You can go first."
- "Let's work together."
- In a conversation, it would sound like a gentle and patient tone, making sure not to interrupt others.

SCRIPTURE PERTAINING TO IT: Mark 10:20-21

The Bible offers us a wonderful example of how people in the Bible learned to practice courtesy with others.

He said to him, "Teacher, I have kept all these since my youth." Jesus, looking at him, loved him and said, "You lack one thing; go, sell what you own, and give the money to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; then come, follow me."
