# 2023-2024 Current Family Priority Re-Enrollment is Now Open!

This year we are increasing the yearly full tuition rate by \$35.00 per month per student. The new yearly rate will be \$7,300 per student. This increase will go toward our staff and programming. Since last spring, our diocesan principals and pastors have worked together in an effort to improve the current wages for our teachers and staff. These new rates will be a supportive measure to maintain our current staff and attract new staff in the future. These additional dollars will help offset some costs of our phenomenal programming which include a health and wellness advisor, a Spanish class for all our students, and support staff in our growing classrooms.

Current families are offered priority re-enrollment now through March 20, 2023. We will open enrollment to new families starting March 21, 2023.

To re-enroll for the 2023-2024 school year all current families will want to complete the following items:

### GOOGLE RE-ENROLLMENT FORM:

Fill out the corresponding Google re-enrollment form (K-8, Pre-K). Form is online only, no paper documents. If you do not have access to a computer/internet please contact the office to use one of our computers. K-8: https://forms.gle/jaWEygiLfHv1ijcVA

If you're a current family and you're adding a new sibling to enroll please enroll them during current family re-enrollment time, which is now through March 20, 2023.

### **FACTS TUITION ASSISTANCE FORM:**

If requesting any amount of tuition assistance (option B or C on tuition agreement) fill out the FACTS online tuition assistance application by your meeting with Mr. Hull or by May 8, 2023 at the very latest: <a href="https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/4L2TZ">https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/4L2TZ</a> Allow at least 5 business days between the time you complete the tuition assistance application and the day you schedule your meeting for processing time.

If your students are Pre-K or you are paying full K-8 tuition of \$7,300 (Option A) per student you do not fill out the FACTS application.

There is a penalty of \$500 if you are requesting tuition assistance and fail to complete the FACTS application by the deadline, May 8, 2023.

### **PAY REGISTRATION FEE:**

Pay minimum registration fee to hold spots via Sycamore link (\$295 is min. to hold K-8 spots per family, \$80 for Pre-k, \$120 for all day Pre-k): <a href="https://app.sycamoreschool.com/public\_paypal.php?appid=426">https://app.sycamoreschool.com/public\_paypal.php?appid=426</a> Put in memo "Reg. fee" if paying online.

We can also accept cash or check in the office. If paying the minimum reg. fee to hold spots at time of enrollment, and there is more than one child being enrolled, the remainder of reg. fees are due by August 1, 2023. You can pay total registration fee now if you want.

FACTS form (if requesting tuition assistance) and making the appointment (5 business days prior for FACTS form and 3 business days prior for re-enrollment form and scheduling appt.)

If current families do not complete re-enrollment process by March 20th they could be subject to losing their spot at the school to a new family if the class fills up before completing re-enrollment fully. Some enrollment meeting spots are for after March 20th, please have everything else done and your appointment at least made by March 20th if choosing a meeting date after 3/20.

### **RE-ENROLLMENT MEETINGS SIGN UP:**

Mr. Hull would like to meet with every family for a quick 15 minutes, K-8 and Pre-k, whether requesting tuition assistance or not. Use Sign Up Genius: <a href="https://www.signupgenius.com/go/30E0F44ABAC-2CA0FC1-tuition">https://www.signupgenius.com/go/30E0F44ABAC-2CA0FC1-tuition</a> to schedule your enrollment meeting with Mr. Hull. Type "Virtual" in the notes section if you'd like a remote meeting via Google Meet. Otherwise in-person meeting will be assumed.

Make sure to leave at least 5 business days in between the time you fill out your enrollment form, FACTS form (if requesting tuition assistance) and making the appointment (5 business days prior for FACTS form and 3 business days prior for re-enrollment form and scheduling appt.)

If current families do not complete re-enrollment process by March 20th they could be subject to losing their spot at the school to a new family if the class fills up before completing re-enrollment fully. Some enrollment meeting spots are for after March 20th, please have everything else done and your appointment at least made by March 20th if choosing a meeting date after 3/20.

If your family account is in arrears, all balances must be paid prior to being approved for re-enroll-ment. Please contact Sharon Greany: sgreany@stmarysspokane.org as soon as possible if you've received an arrears notice.

Immunization records are now required to be on the WA Dept. of Health Certificate of Immunization Status (CIS) form for student records. Please provide updated records by first day of school on Sept. 5, 2023.

Virtus volunteer training completion, background check and disclosure is required prior to volunteering at school. Yearly online training updates are due each year and background check must be renewed every 5 years.

- 1. Go to www.virtusonline.org
- 2. Click on new registrant and fill-in your information with location where you will volunteer.

  Our location is: Spokane, WA (Diocese)
- 3. Select Protecting God's Children Online Awareness Session 3.0
- 4. Required documents:
  - Acknowledge Code of Conduct, state name and date.
  - Answer Yes/No questions for Disclosure Statement Form
- 5. Fill-in background check information through Selection.com/Fastrax
- 6. Complete training module: Protecting God's Children Online Awareness Session 3.0

(approximately 30 minutes)

7. After you have completed your online training and passed the background check without any convictions, the Office of Child and Youth Protection will approve them in the VIRTUS database.


Good evening everyone! Please see below for a list of weekly events here at St. Mary during Lent:

### PILAU (SPICED RICE) RECIPE **KENYA**

Makes 6-8 servings

1 t ground cumin

1 1/2 t all spice

½ t black pepper

1/4 cup vegetable oil

1 medium red onion, thinly sliced

4 cloves garlic, minced

2 tablespoons ginger, minced

1 cinnamon stick

1 large potato, peeled and cut into 1 inch chunks

4 c water

2 c basmati rice

In a medium bowl, combine the cumin, all spice, and black pepper. Set aside. Heat a large pot over medium-high heat. Add the oil and red onion and sauté for 10-15 minutes, until dark brown. Add the garlic, ginger, cinnamon stick, and spice mix. Cook for 1-2 minutes. Add the potatoes and the water. Bring to a boil and cook for 10 minutes. Add the rice, stir, and cover. Reduce the heat to medium-low and cook for 20 minutes, until the rice is cooked, and the liquid is absorbed.
