- 11:30am Mass in the church followed by an opportunity for confessions. Mass and Confessions will be celebrated by the Capuchin Friars.
- You may visit the altar of St. Francis which is enhanced with an image of the Transitus of St. Francis. You are able to leave your prayers and requests in the basket provided.

**An indulgence is defined as “a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church, which, as the minister of redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury of the satisfactions of Christ and the saints” (CIC 992; CCC 1471).**
