

This weekend we celebrate the great feast of the Ascension. 40 days after He rose from the grave on Easter Sunday, Jesus ascended to his heavenly throne and sits at the Father's right hand. As Pope Benedict XVI said, "the Ascension of the Lord means that Christ has not departed from us, but that he is now, thanks to his being with the Father, close to each one of us forever. Each one of us can be on intimate terms with him; each can call upon him. The Lord is always within hearing. We can inwardly draw away from him. We can live turning our backs on him. But he always waits for us and is always close to us." (2005)


