

Dear Friends and Family of Holy Family Parish,

19th Sunday in Ordinary Time.

Today our first reading from the First Book of Kings, tells the story from the life of the prophet Elijah where an angel miraculously feeds him. The second reading is from the Letter of St. Paul to the Ephesians, in which he urges his converts to live in peace, harmony and love with one another. In the Gospel, we continue to read from the "Bread of Life Discourse" found in John. We have been reading from this chapter for the past two weeks and will continue to read from it for another two weeks. Last week, the crowd asked for a sign that would show that Jesus came from God. Jesus replied by saying that he is the sign and the bread of life sent by God. In the following verses, Jesus says that he was sent by God to do the Father's will. Jesus promises that those who look upon the Son with faith will find eternal life. And, when those in the crowd complain about his claims, Jesus responds to the complaints by saying that only those who are chosen by God will recognize him as the one that God sent. This is a recurring theme in John's Gospel, that God has chosen those who will have faith in Jesus. Jesus promises that the bread of life will bring eternal life to those who partake of it, and he tells us that the bread of life will be his own flesh, given for the life of the world. We celebrate this gift of Jesus each time we gather for Mass, because we believe that receiving Jesus in the Eucharist will lead us to eternal life.

Holy Water Fonts. There will not be holy water fonts at the side entrances for a little while. There will still be holy water at the front entrance, from the Narthex. This will allow us to monitor the font and make sure that it is always fresh and clean. This is only a temporary situation. Thank you for your patience and understanding.

Sacred Silence

We realize that some people are very happy to finally be out of lock-down and to be congregating with their friends and loved ones, and it's understandable that we want to talk and share. But we again humbly request that all non-essential conversations take place outside, and please use a whispered "inside voice" for those necessary and urgent conversations. The courtyards and the portico are excellent spots for catching up with friends.

Pope Francis had this to say:

"Praying, as every true dialogue, is also knowing how to be in silence — in dialogues there are moments of silence — in silence together with Jesus. When we go to Mass, perhaps we arrive five minutes early and begin to chat with the person next to us. But this is not the moment for small talk; it is the moment of silence to prepare ourselves for the dialogue.

It is the moment for recollection within the heart, to prepare ourselves for the encounter with Jesus. Silence is so important!"

And it is a beautiful act of mercy and charity not to disrupt the quietude and prayerfulness that many people look forward to and have a right to experience when they visit the church, arrive early before Mass, and/or stay after Mass to pray.

A few reminders:

- 1) Our Sunday obligation is to attend the <u>entire Mass</u>, which begins with the entrance hymn/song and ends when the priest and other ministers recess out.
- 2) Please remember that the sign of peace should be exchanged only at the invitation of the priest or deacon.
- 3) Only Catholics who are in good standing, i.e., the state of grace, should receive Holy Communion: at minimum this means that you believe what the Church believes, you regularly practice the faith, you have received sacramental absolution for any serious sin, and if you are married, you are married according to the Church's norms.
- 4) Procedure for receiving Communion.
 - a) As you approach the sanctuary, please line up shoulder to shoulder around the front step and the minister will approach you one at a time. After you receive the Eucharist, please return to your pew down the side aisle. The next person in line should fill in the vacant spot immediately.
 - b) If you are seated in the side sections, and there is no extraordinary minister of Holy Communion, please wait until those in the center sections have received and then approach the sanctuary from the side aisle.
 - c) If you would like to receive kneeling and/or on the tongue, please come to left side of the sanctuary.






