# Parish Information

## 22<sup>nd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

The Scriptures this week offer a great challenge to each of us: how sincere is our worship, how true is our faith? Moses reminds us that God has shown his love for us by revealing the Law and the Commandments, and that our obedience to the Will of God and to His Law is a powerful sign to the world of God's love and providence. And we are called to right and true worship by Jesus and St. James in the New Testament readings. On Tuesday this week we celebrated the feast of St. Bartholomew. At Mass that day we heard Jesus say that there was no duplicity in Bartholomew, that his interior life and exterior life were in total harmony. This is the expectation for each of us, and this is the challenge that we all face. As St. Paul says in Romans Chapter 7, it is like there is a war within us, that we have trouble doing the right thing and feel almost compelled to do the wrong. It is a battle we all face and without sacramental grace it is a battle we all lose. Ask God for a renewed outpouring of the grace of your baptism, allow God to draw you close to Himself in the Holy Eucharist, go to confession if you need to especially if it's been a while: God's mercy is waiting for you. If you do this, if you allow your heart to be transformed, then the responsorial psalm will become a reality for you and your family; you will surely be living in the presence of the Lord.

We are undoubtedly living in times of great uncertainty, chaos, and fear. There is much distrust of our leaders both in government and in the Church; we are fighting the Covid-19 pandemic; the devil is surely sowing seeds of distrust and division. In chapter 17 verse 21 of St. Matthew's Gospel, Jesus powerfully says, "This type of demon cannot be cast out in any way but through prayer and fasting."

Interestingly, over the last week or so one of the people that I follow on social media began to post about a book she was reading on the spiritual practice of fasting. Fasting is an ancient practice for Christians and has many spiritual and physical benefits. Unfortunately, in recent times the practice has fallen out of favor and is usually only observed during the season of Lent.

Traditionally, Christians would fast on Wednesday and Friday of each week; taking only bread and water for the entire day. While there are other ways to fast, the spiritual fathers of our Church are clear that fasting from food is the most efficacious way to fast. And this is what Jesus was referring to in the Gospel.

"It's a common complaint of our modern world that it's noisy and materialistic. What better way to light a candle in the world than to join in fasting and prayer? If fasting feels uncomfortable, that's an even better reason to start it. Making fasting a regular part of the spiritual life will bring transformation with it. Immerse yourself in the wisdom of the saints and the call of Jesus Himself: "Jesus' call to conversion and penance, like that of the prophets before him, does not aim first at outward works, 'sackcloth and ashes,' fasting and mortification, but at the conversion of the heart, interior conversion. Without this, such penances remain sterile and false; however, interior conversion urges expression in visible signs, gestures and works of penance." (CCC #1430)

After praying about this, I think the Lord is inviting us to take up this spiritual weapon once again. I know that not everyone can jump into the deep end and do the bread and water fast twice a week, maybe not even once a week. But maybe you can

skip one meal those days, or not eat between meals, or not until after sunset, or do a 12-hour fast. Prayerfully consider what you can do, ask the Lord for the strength and grace to persevere, and say yes to the Lord's invitation. The world, the Church, and our parish need you.

## Health Information

Each day we are hearing of more and more people who are sick, some with the corona virus, others with respiratory complications, the flu, or other viruses. Please be considerate of each other and take precautions such as washing hands frequently and avoiding unnecessary touching (hugging and shaking hands). Everyone is free to wear a mask if you feel it necessary, and the bishop expects anyone who is not vaccinated to wear a mask at Mass.

Also, please remember that when Bishop Estévez reinstated the obligation to attend Sunday Mass, he reminded us that one does not have an obligation to attend Mass on Sunday in the following circumstances:

1. You are ill, or your health condition would be significantly compromised if you were to contract an infectious illness (i.e., you have underlying conditions or are in a high-risk category).
2. You exhibit flu-like symptoms.
3. You have good reason to think you might be asymptomatic of a contagious illness (e.g., you were in recent contact with someone who tested positive for a contagious illness such as COVID or influenza).
4. You care for the sick, homebound, or infirm.
5. You are pregnant.
6. Those 65 years of age or older (per the CDC's recommendation of high-risk individuals).
7. You cannot attend Mass through no fault of your own (e.g., no Mass is offered, you are infirm, or, while wanting to go, you are prevented for some reason you cannot control (e.g., your ride did not show up, the church was at capacity)).

## Reminders for receiving Holy Communion

- ◇ As you approach the sanctuary, please line up shoulder to shoulder around the front step and the minister will approach you one at a time. After you receive the Eucharist, please return to your pew down the side aisle. The next person in line should fill in the vacant spot immediately.
- ◇ If you are seated in the side sections, and there is no extraordinary minister of Holy Communion, please wait until those in the center sections have received and then approach the sanctuary from the side aisle.


