A message from Fr. David:

24th Sunday in Ordinary Time

For the past few weeks, the second reading at Sunday Mass has been from the Letter of St. James; I heard a preacher say one time that if we ever start to feel good about ourselves then we should read St. James' letter. It surely packs a punch and forces us to come face to face with just how well we are responding to the demands of the Gospel, in particular our love for our neighbor. St. James makes it abundantly clear that our faith in God and in His Church necessarily must show itself in the way we live our lives.

One of the dangers of our society that is so heavily dependent on government assistance (which frequently is necessary) is that we are separated from this basic demand of the Gospel. Let the letter of St. James challenge each of us to demonstrate our faith with our works. Here at Holy Family, we have two groups that do exceptional work reaching out to our friends and neighbors in need: Helping Hands, and the St. Vincent de Paul Society. Please consider getting involved in one of these ministries, or in some other charity or apostolate that serves those in need. One of the great saints said, quite dramatically yet truthfully: the poor need the rich to keep from going hungry, and the rich need the poor to keep from going to hell.

This Saturday, September 11, we are having a Morning of Reflection for the parish, high-school age and up. It begins at 9:00 am with daily Mass and will finish by Noon. There will be a brief reflection, time for personal prayer, priests available for confession, Eucharistic Exposition and Benediction. And you will be home in time for the football games:)!

Health Information

First Aid Antiseptic: Walmart generously donated over 50 bottles of 70% Isopropyl Alcohol to us. If you would like a free bottle, please come by the Parish Office to pick one up.

Each day we are hearing of more and more people who are sick, some with the corona virus, others with respiratory complications, the flu, or other viruses. Please be considerate of each other and take precautions such as washing hands frequently and avoiding unnecessary touching (hugging and shaking hands). Everyone is free to wear a mask if you feel it necessary, and the bishop expects anyone who is not vaccinated to wear a mask at Mass.

Also, please remember that when Bishop Estèvez reinstated the obligation to attend Sunday Mass, he reminded us that one does not have an obligation to attend Mass on Sunday in the following circumstances:

- 1. You are ill, or your health condition would be significantly compromised if you were to contract an infectious illness (i.e., you have underlying conditions or are in a high-risk category).
- 2. You exhibit flu-like symptoms.
- 3. You have good reason to think you might be asymptomatic of a contagious illness (e.g., you were in recent contact with someone who tested positive for a contagious illness such as COVID or influenza.
- 4. You care for the sick, homebound, or infirm.
- 5. You are pregnant.
- 6. Those 65 years of age or older (per the CDC's recommendation of high-risk individuals).
- 7. You cannot attend Mass through no fault of your own (e.g., no Mass is offered, you are infirm, or, while wanting to go, you are prevented for some reason you cannot control (e.g., your ride did not show up, the church was at capacity).

Reminders for receiving Holy Communion

- As you approach the sanctuary, please line up shoulder to shoulder around the front step and the minister will approach you one at a time. After you receive the Eucharist, please return to your pew down the side aisle. The next person in line should fill in the vacant spot immediately.
- ♦ If you are seated in the side sections, and there is no extraordinary minister of Holy Communion, please wait until those in the center sections have received and then approach the sanctuary from the side aisle.
