Parish Information

A message from Fr. David:

HAPPY NEW YEAR! This Sunday is the First Sunday of Advent and marks the beginning of a new liturgical year: The Year of Grace 2022. This is the 3rd year of the 3-year Gospel cycle for Sunday Mass, so our Gospel passages this year will come mainly from the Gospel according to St. Luke.

Advent (which means “coming”) is a joyous season filled with hope as we wait the coming of our Savior Jesus Christ. But it is also a penitential season as Mother Church calls us to prayerfully prepare our hearts, our homes, and our families not only for the Birth of Jesus on Christmas, but as the readings this weekend point out, also for the King’s return at the end of time. Which is the same focus our readings had as we concluded the liturgical year.

I remember as a child we always hung our felt Advent Calendar; it was shaped like a Christmas tree and had snap-on ornaments to help us count down the days. Also, my mom had a “manger/crib” for the Baby Jesus that we were responsible for getting ready so that Jesus would have a nice place to be born. It was basically a small shoe-box that we would add a cotton ball to each time we did a good deed. So it was a race to make sure that Jesus had a soft bed. I’m sure that each of us has a favorite family tradition that helps us keep our hearts and minds (and wallets) in the right place during this wonderful time of the year.

The Advent Season is a wonderful time to slow down and refocus. We need a special grace to resist the pressures of the commercialized culture which is trying to force us into an early celebration of Christmas. But Christmas doesn’t begin until the afternoon of December 24th. So we truly are in this time between the *already* (Bethlehem) and the *not yet* (2nd Coming). May this season be one of hope, peace, joy, and love.

Health Information

Each day we are hearing of more and more people who are sick, some with the corona virus, others with respiratory complications, the flu, or other viruses. Please be considerate of each other and take precautions such as washing hands frequently and avoiding unnecessary touching (hugging and shaking hands). Everyone is free to wear a mask if you feel it necessary, and the Bishop expects anyone who is not vaccinated to wear a mask at Mass.

Also, please remember that when Bishop Estévez reinstated the obligation to attend Sunday Mass, he reminded us that one does not have an obligation to attend Mass on Sunday in the following circumstances:

1. You are ill, or your health condition would be significantly compromised if you were to contract an infectious illness (i.e., you have underlying conditions or are in a high-risk category).
2. You exhibit flu-like symptoms.
3. You have good reason to think you might be asymptomatic of a contagious illness (e.g., you were in recent contact with someone who tested positive for a contagious illness such as COVID or influenza).
4. You care for the sick, homebound, or infirm.
5. You are pregnant.
6. Those 65 years of age or older (per the CDC's recommendation of high-risk individuals).
7. You cannot attend Mass through no fault of your own (e.g., no Mass is offered, you are infirm), or, while wanting to go, you are prevented for some reason you cannot control, (e.g., your ride did not show up, the church was at capacity).

Reminders for receiving Holy Communion

- ◇ As you approach the sanctuary, please line up shoulder to shoulder around the front step and the minister will approach you one at a time. After you receive the Eucharist, please return to your pew down the side aisle. The next person in line should fill in the vacant spot immediately.
- ◇ If you are seated in the side sections, and there is no extraordinary minister of Holy Communion, please wait until those in the center sections have received and then approach the sanctuary from the side aisle.

Did you know?

According to the Second Vatican Council, in order to interpret Scripture according to the Spirit, we must: a. Be especially attentive to the content and unity of the whole Scripture, b. Read the Scripture within the living Tradition of the whole Church, c. Be attentive to the analogy of faith. (CCC #111-114)
