Parish Information

A message from Fr. David:

3rd Sunday of Advent: as the Advent Wreath gets brighter, we are reminded that the True Light of the World is getting ever closer.

“Gaudete in Domino semper - Rejoice in the Lord always (Phil 4: 4). Holy Mass of the Third Sunday of Advent opens with these words of St Paul and is therefore called “gaudete” Sunday. The Apostle urges Christians to rejoice because the Lord’s coming, that is, his glorious return, is certain and will not be delayed. The Church makes this invitation her own while she prepares to celebrate Christmas and her gaze is focused ever more intently on Bethlehem. Indeed, we wait with hope, certain of Christ’s second coming because we have experienced his first. The mystery of Bethlehem reveals to us God-with-us, the God close to us and not merely in the spatial and temporal sense; he is close to us because he has, as it were, “espoused” our humanity; he has taken our condition upon himself, choosing to be like us in all things save sin in order to make us become like him. Christian joy thus springs from this certainty: God is close, he is with me, he is with us, in joy and in sorrow, in sickness and in health, as a friend and faithful spouse. And this joy endures, even in trials, in suffering itself. It does not remain only on the surface; it dwells in the depths of the person who entrusts himself to God and trusts in him.”

I hope everyone will be joining us this weekend for our mini-Advent Retreat: Friday, December 10 and Saturday, December 11. Friday evening begins at 6:30 pm with the rosary, then Mass, then Eucharistic Adoration, praise and worship, and intercessory prayer, and Saturday’s morning of reflection begins with 9am Mass, then a reflection talk, followed by quiet prayer/Eucharistic adoration and confessions.

And as you are making your New Year’s Eve plans, we will have Mass at 4:00 pm, followed by an amazing Holiday Concert ending at 6:00 pm, which will give plenty of time for dinner and to stop by your holiday party, then you can come back and end the year and begin the new one in front of the Blessed Sacrament with a beautiful Holy Hour.

Nursing Mother’s Room

As a reminder, we have created a space that can be used by moms who need to nurse their babies during Mass. It is located off the Narthex next to the water fountains. Outside of Mass it is used for other things, but during Mass we are reserving it for the moms who are looking for some privacy as they nurse. Please note – the room is not to be used as a “cry room”.

I know that our “children’s choir” is a problem and a distraction for some of you, but I’m asking for patience and understanding. One of the most beautiful blessings of our parish is that we have so many small kids and babies (and many pregnant moms!). It is a real joy to see that so many of our families are embracing the Church’s teaching on marriage and family and are radically open to life. Many families

have told me of the negative experiences that they have had at other parishes where they were told to leave or made to feel very unwelcomed because their children were “being disruptive”.

That being said, for those with active children, please keep in mind that with the acoustics in our church their voices do carry, so please be sensitive to those around you. Feel free to step out momentarily into the Narthex or out the side door if you need to quiet your child. And for those who are sitting near-by and have an available arm or lap, I know that many of our parents would more than appreciate a little help when one of their little ones is getting restless.

And it is good to keep in mind what Pope Francis so wonderfully said:

Health Information

Each day we are hearing of more and more people who are sick, some with the corona virus, others with respiratory complications, the flu, or other viruses. Please be considerate of each other and take precautions such as washing hands frequently and avoiding unnecessary touching (hugging and shaking hands). Everyone is free to wear a mask if you feel it necessary, and the Bishop expects anyone who is not vaccinated to wear a mask at Mass.

Also, please remember that when Bishop Estévez reinstated the obligation to attend Sunday Mass, he reminded us that one does not have an obligation to attend Mass on Sunday in the following circumstances:

1. You are ill, or your health condition would be significantly compromised if you were to contract an infectious illness (i.e., you have underlying conditions or are in a high-risk category).
2. You exhibit flu-like symptoms.
3. You have good reason to think you might be asymptomatic of a contagious illness (e.g., you were in recent contact with someone who tested positive for a contagious illness such as COVID or influenza).
4. You care for the sick, homebound, or infirm.
5. You are pregnant.
6. Those 65 years of age or older (per the CDC's recommendation of high-risk individuals).
7. You cannot attend Mass through no fault of your own (e.g., no Mass is offered, you are infirm), or, while wanting to go, you are prevented for some reason you cannot control, (e.g., your ride did not show up, the church was at capacity).

Did you know?

The Old Covenant has never been revoked. The Church has always opposed the idea of rejecting the Old Testament under the pretext that the New Testament has rendered it void. The Old Testament declares in prophecy the coming of Christ and prepares us for it. (CCC #121-123)
