





A message from Fr. David:

On behalf of Fr. Mason, the parish staff, Mr. Moloney and the school staff, as we remember the birth of our Savior I sincerely hope that our families and our homes experience the peace and joy that only His presence can bring.

For many of us this past year has brought untold blessings and graces for which we offer thanks and praise to our Heavenly Father, for others, this year has brought sadness and pain, especially for those who are mourning the death of a loved one. And to you, we unite ourselves with your prayers for consolation and joy.

It is in the ordinariness, which often means ‘the messiness’, of our lives the Jesus desires once again to take on flesh and to dwell. Did you know?

Typology refers to that study of Scripture which focuses on how prefigurations of the Old Covenant are accomplished in the fullness of time in the person of Jesus Christ. The New Testament has to be read in light of the Old since the New Testament lies hidden in the Old and the Old Testament is unveiled in the New. (CCC #128-129)

Health Information

Each day we are hearing of more and more people who are sick, some with the corona virus, others with respiratory complications, the flu, or other viruses. Please be considerate of each other and take precautions such as washing hands frequently and avoiding unnecessary touching (hugging and shaking hands). Everyone is free to wear a mask if you feel it necessary, and the Bishop expects anyone who is not vaccinated to wear a mask at Mass.

Also, please remember that when Bishop Estèvez reinstated the obligation to attend Sunday Mass, he reminded us that one does not have an obligation to attend Mass on Sunday in the following circumstances:

1. You are ill, or your health condition would be significantly compromised if you were to contract an infectious illness (i.e., you have underlying conditions or are in a high-risk category).
2. You exhibit flu-like symptoms.
3. You have good reason to think you might be asymptomatic of a contagious illness (e.g., you were in recent contact with someone who tested positive for a contagious illness such as COVID or influenza).
4. You care for the sick, homebound, or infirm.
5. You are pregnant.
6. Those 65 years of age or older (per the CDC's recommendation of high-risk individuals).
7. You cannot attend Mass through no fault of your own (e.g., no Mass is offered, you are infirm), or, while wanting to go, you are prevented for some reason you cannot control, (e.g., your ride did not show up, the church was at capacity).

Scholarships for Florida School children



Step Up For Students believes that every child deserves the chance to succeed. Through the administration of several scholarship programs, Step Up For Students empowers parents to pursue and engage in the most appropriate learning options for their children. With the help of a Step Up For Students scholarship, you could send your child to a Catholic school near you.

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR PRIVATE SCHOOL

The Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options (FES-EO) and the Florida Tax Credit (FTC) Scholarship Program give parents the ability to choose a school that best meets their children's needs by providing a scholarship to attend an eligible private school.

Who is eligible?

Students in grades K-12 who meet one or more of the following:

- Financial need: Eligibility is determined by household income. For example, a family of four could have an income of nearly \$100,000 annually to qualify.
- Dependent children of a reservist or an active-duty member of the United States Armed Forces
- Children currently in foster or out-of-home care
- Siblings of students participating in the Family Empowerment Scholarship for Students with Unique Abilities

What is available?

- A scholarship worth roughly \$7,000 to cover the cost of private school tuition, books, registration, testing and more.

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STUDENTS WITH UNIQUE ABILITIES

The Family Empowerment Scholarship for Students with Unique Abilities (FES-UA) allows parents of students with unique abilities to personalize the education of their children by directing scholarship dollars toward a combination of programs and services offered by approved providers.

Who is eligible?

- Students 3 years old to high-school graduation or age 22 (whichever comes first)
- Children with one of 22 diagnoses including, but not limited to: autism spectrum disorder, Down syndrome, spina bifida and emotional, behavioral or intellectual disabilities

What is available?

- A scholarship worth, on average, \$10,400 to cover the cost of private school tuition, instructional materials, home education, tutoring and more.
