A message from Fr. David:

"They have no wine." Who would have ever guessed that such a simple observation would be so life-changing? As Mother Church asks us to reflect on the Wedding Feast at Cana this weekend, we get a glimpse into the intercessory role of the saints and, in particular, that of Our Blessed Mother. The simplicity of her words veils their immense power as she calls attention to the plight of the unnamed married couple. And how fitting it is, that this first miracle of Jesus takes place at a wedding feast! So often in the Sacred Scriptures and in the writings of the saints the imagery of marriage is used to describe the relationship between God and His people.

This week, Fr. Mason will be leading a group from our parish on a pilgrimage to Washington, D.C. to participate in the March for Life and prayerfully protest the legal killing of babies through the barbaric practice of abortion. What a sad world we live in when we have settled for the lie that killing a baby is a good choice. We join our prayers with them and hope that this will be the last year that this march is necessary. We also pray for healing for all the men and women who are suffering from their decision to abort their child.

Exodus 90

Did vou know?

Baptism comes from Christ's death on the cross. The blood and water that flowed from the pierced side of Jesus on the cross are types of Baptism and Eucharist. It is from this moment on that we are able to be born of water and spirit and walk in newness of life. (CCC #1225)

Health Information

Each day we are hearing of more and more people who are sick, some with the corona virus or its variants, others with respiratory complications, the flu, or other viruses. Please be considerate of each other and take precautions such as washing hands frequently and avoiding unnecessary touching (hugging and shaking hands). Everyone is free to wear a mask if you feel it necessary, and the Bishop expects anyone who is not vaccinated to wear a mask at Mass.

Also, please remember that when Bishop Estévez reinstated the obligation to attend Sunday Mass, he reminded us that one does not have an obligation to attend Mass on Sunday in the following circumstances:

- 1. You are ill, or your health condition would be significantly compromised if you were to contract an infectious illness (i.e., you have underlying conditions or are in a high-risk category).
- 2. You exhibit flu-like symptoms.
- 3. You have good reason to think you might be asymptomatic of a contagious illness (e.g., you were in recent contact with someone who tested positive for a contagious illness such as COVID or influenza).
- 4. You care for the sick, homebound, or infirm.
- 5. You are pregnant.
- 6. Those 65 years of age or older (per the CDC's recommendation of high-risk individuals).
- 7. You cannot attend Mass through no fault of your own (e.g., no Mass is offered, you are infirm), or, while wanting to go, you are prevented for some reason you cannot control, (e.g., your ride did not show up, the church was at capacity).


