

Parish Information

A Message from Fr. David:

The Gospel for the 5th Week of Lent in Year C presents to us the story of the woman caught in adultery. As is the case for most of the Gospel stories, there are many layers to this encounter. I invite you all to spend some of your personal prayer time this week reviewing this passage asking the Holy Spirit to reveal to you more of the Merciful Face of the Father. The passage ends with one of the greatest commands that Jesus offers to each of us: after we encounter his saving mercy, we are to “go and sin no more.” At the 9am Mass, we have the 3rd and final scrutiny for those preparing to be baptized at the Easter Vigil. At that Mass we will hear the account of the raising of Lazarus from the dead. The final sign that St. John’s Gospel presents to us prepares us for the reality of discipleship. As we surrender our lives under the Lordship of Jesus Christ, we too, are brought out of the tomb of sin and death and are called out into the new life that Jesus promises.

Holy Communion:

As we know *the Eucharist IS the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus Christ*, therefore we should treat the Host with the upmost respect and reverence. (And the Church building, the Mass, and our bodies as well.)

I am sure you have noticed how delicately we handle the Eucharist and care for the vessels, and how meticulously the vessels are purified after distribution. I am asking everyone to be more aware of our attitude toward the Eucharist: do we truly believe in the Real Presence? Does our entire life reflect our belief? In particular, I ask this in reference to the manner of reception for those who are in the state of grace and are well prepared to receive Holy Communion. The Church does allow for receiving in the hand (it is the norm in the U.S.), so I am not saying that you should not do so, but if you do choose this manner, please be aware of the high possibility that small particles of the host probably do remain in your palm and on your fingers. Also, if you do receive in the hand, you must consume the host as soon as it is distributed, do not walk away from the minister without consuming. If this happens, the ushers are instructed to approach the person and ask them to consume immediately. Over the past couple of months we have had some acts of desecration toward the Eucharist and some cases of the Host being dropped. Please remember that there is no rush, what’s most important is the reverent reception of Holy Communion.

Holy Week:

We are so close to the holiest time of the Liturgical Year, next weekend we celebrate Palm Sunday and enter into the “week that changed the world.” I earnestly invite everyone to participate in the various liturgies that set the foundation for our life as members of the body of Christ:

The Solemn procession will take place prior to the 7:00 am Mass; please gather in the courtyard.
