## A message from Fr. David:

“Do you love me”? Jesus asks Simon Peter this question three times in this week’s Gospel. Scripture scholars tell us that these 3 questions allow Peter to make amends for the three times he denied Christ during the Passion. This is another example of the mercy of God, who tirelessly reaches down to us, even when we are at our lowest, and provides an opportunity for reconciliation. As the Easter Season continues, we will see in the Mass readings the abundant fruit that comes about as more and more people encounter the mercy and reconciliation of God offered through the ministry of the Church.

I once again want to express my gratitude and appreciation for all the hard work (mostly done quietly behind the scenes) that went into such a glorious celebration of the Easter Triduum; we continue to hear so many good things about how beautiful everything was and how joy-filled and welcoming our community is. We also received quite a number of new registrations. We definitely are experiencing an outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon our parish, and I am so excited to see what the Spirit does next.

I also want to acknowledge what I perceive to be a deepening of our Eucharistic devotion as a parish. I know we talk often about proper reverence and procedures to receive. We do this because we know how precious the gift of the Eucharist is, and we want to share that with all of you. There really is nothing more important. And I cannot tell you how wonderful it is to get to be part of this renewal and revival. It is a joy to be part of this wonderful and growing and Spirit-filled community. Thank you!

This weekend is the first Sunday of the month, so as we have done for the past few months, we will end the 9am Sunday Mass with a brief period of Eucharistic Exposition and Benediction.
