## A Reflection by Deacon Don:

28<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

The theme of Baptism permeates our Readings this weekend. We see it in the cleansings of two lepers: Naaman, a Syrian, and an unnamed Samaritan who lived more than 800 years later. We also see it referenced in St. Paul's instruction to Timothy. Our 1st Reading and our Gospel highlight the cleansing of 2 lepers that result from their first encounter with God; our 2nd Reading points to the truth that is symbolized in the rite of the Sacrament.

What we aren't told in today's 1<sup>st</sup> Reading is that Naaman was the army commander of the King of Syria. When he heard that there was a prophet in Israel who could cure his leprosy, Naaman immediately sought him out. Elisha told Naaman to "Go wash seven times in the Jordan [River], and your flesh will heal and you will be clean." (2 Kgs 5:10) Naaman, expecting some grand invocation of his God from this prophet, was furious. To wash in the muddy waters of the Jordan was insulting! But his servants reasoned with him: "If the prophet had told you to do something extraordinary, would you not have done it?" (2 Kgs 5:13) In obedience, Naaman did as Elisha commanded and he was cured. But then came the real miracle – Naaman's conversion and his profession of faith: "Now I know that there is no God in all the earth, except in Israel." (2 Kgs 5:15)

In the case of the Samaritan, he was one of 10 lepers who sought out Jesus to be cured. Following the provisions of Mosaic Law, Jesus said to them, "Go show yourselves to the priests." (Lk 17:14) And on their way to the priests, they were cleansed. Again, there was no spectacular ritual; just a simple act of obedience wrought the miraculous cure. But of greater importance was the conversion of the Samaritan – who, like Naaman, was a foreigner. "Realizing he had been healed, [he] returned, glorifying God in a loud voice, and [he] fell at the feet of Jesus and thanked him." (Lk 17:15-16) And his profession of faith merited him salvation: Jesus said to him, "Stand up and go; your faith has saved you." (Lk 17:19)

Both cleansings are signs of Baptism. As Naaman and the Samaritan were cleansed of their leprosy, in the Sacrament of Baptism, we are cleansed of Original Sin (and, if we are older, of all actual sin – sins that we knowingly committed). As Naaman and the Samaritan were cleansed as the result of their first encounters with God, our souls are cleansed of sin as the result of our first sacramental encounter with God. And just as the cleansings of Naaman and the Samaritan involved no astonishing signs, neither does the essential rite of the Sacrament of Baptism – either a simple triple immersion into water or the triple pouring of water, with the invocation of the Blessed Trinity. That's all. Frighteningly simple. If you blink, you miss it. (Thank God for photographs and videos!) But the effect is truly miraculous! In the Sacrament of Baptism, we enter into the Paschal Mystery – the death and resurrection of Jesus. That is the theological truth referenced by St. Paul in our 2nd Reading. He tells Timothy, "If we have died with [Jesus], we shall also live with Him..." (2 Tm 2:11) In Baptism, we die with Christ to sin and are buried with Him (signified by our immersion into the Baptismal waters). When we are brought out of the waters, we rise with Jesus to new life.

To the best of our knowledge, Naaman and the Samaritan physically encountered God only once, yet their responses to those encounters were life-changing. Through the Sacraments, we have many encounters with God. At each Mass, we are privileged to encounter God in the Person of Jesus in the Eucharist. Again, nothing visually spectacular. Just Jesus veiled by the sacramental species. But Jesus nonetheless! The question facing all of us: will we recognize Jesus when we encounter Him? What will be our response?

## PRAY THE ROSARY WITH US!

**October is dedicated to the Holy Rosary**, and on **October 7**, Holy Mother Church celebrated the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary.

I invite everyone to take up the practice of praying the rosary each day, especially among families. And I share the following quotes in the rosary from Pope Benedict XVI:

1. "Today, together we confirm that the Holy Rosary is not a pious practice banished to the past, like prayers of other times thought of with nostalgia. Instead, the Rosary is experiencing a new Springtime. Without a doubt, this is one of the most eloquent signs of love that the young generation nourish for Jesus and his Mother, Mary."

2. "The rosary is a means given by the Virgin for contemplating Jesus and, meditating on his life, for loving and following him always more faithfully."

3. "Dear young people, I invite you to value this traditional Marian prayer which helps us to understand better the central moments of salvation realized by Christ."

4. To newlyweds, he said, "to make the praying of the rosary in the family a moment of spiritual growth under the maternal gaze of the Virgin Mary."

5. "When reciting the Rosary, the important and meaningful moments of salvation history are relived. The various steps of Christ's mission are traced. With Mary the heart is oriented toward the mystery of Jesus. Christ is put at the centre of our life, of our time, of our city, through the contemplation and meditation of his holy mysteries of joy, light, sorrow and glory."

6. "The Rosary, when it is prayed in an authentic way, not mechanical and superficial but profoundly, it brings, in fact, peace and reconciliation. It contains within itself the healing power of the Most Holy Name of Jesus, invoked with faith and love at the centre of each 'Hail Mary'".

7. The Rosary "the prayer of the Christian who advances in the pilgrimage of faith, in the following of Jesus, preceded by Mary."
