Parish Information

A Message from Fr. David:

HAPPY NEW YEAR! This weekend we celebrate the 1st Sunday of Advent. Beginning the Church's liturgical year, Advent (from, "ad-venire" in Latin or "to come to") is the season encompassing the four Sundays (and weekdays) leading up to the celebration of Christmas. The Advent season is a time of preparation that directs our hearts and minds to Christ's second coming at the end of time and to the anniversary of Our Lord's birth on Christmas.

Pope St. John Paul II reminds us that: "The liturgy of Advent, filled with constant allusions to the joyful expectation of the Messiah, helps us to understand the fullness of the value and meaning of the mystery of Christmas. It is not just about commemorating the historical event, which occurred some 2,000 years ago in a little village of Judea. Instead, we must understand that our whole life should be an "advent", in vigilant expectation of Christ's final coming. To prepare our hearts to welcome the Lord who, as we say in the Creed, will come one day to judge the living and the dead, we must learn to recognize his presence in the events of daily life. Advent is then a period of intense training that directs us decisively to the One who has already come, who will come and who continuously comes."

As we are beginning this new liturgical year, I thought it would be good to offer some liturgical reminders to assist with the worthy celebration of the Holy Mass:

- All Catholics are obliged to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation. In order to satisfy the obligation, you must attend the entire Mass. A good rule of thumb is that the priest and ministers are the last ones in, and the first ones out.
- The Church asks for silence inside the church and in the surrounding areas.
- Food and drink should not be brought into the nave (the main part of the church).
- Liturgical postures during Mass (I know this is a touchy subject):
- ~ the faithful should not lift/elevate their hands during the Our Father, or in response to the greeting "The Lord be with you"
 - ~ the sign of peace is not a spontaneous act among the laity; it should be exchanged ONLY in response to the invitation of the priest or deacon
- Reception of Holy Communion:
 - ~ You must be free from mortal sin, and you must fast for 1 hour before
 - ~ You have the option to receive standing or kneeling, on the tongue or in the hand
 - ~ If receiving standing, you must make a profound bow before receiving
 - ~ If receiving in the hand

both hands must be free (you shouldn't be holding anything: rosary, purse, or a child, etc.) place one hand on top of the other, not side by side, make a "throne', don't grab receive immediately, don't walk away with Jesus

~ If receiving on the tongue

keep head steady, tilt head back slightly, open mouth, extend tongue beyond teeth.

I remember in college once I was leading a group of women. Our theme for the semester was "Rejoice", and quite honestly I did not feel like rejoicing or being joyful. I prayed for joy to fill my heart so I could lead the women well. Yet, I still did not feel joyful. One morning, I walked out of my dorm on my way to class. It was cold, snowy, and early in the morning. All I wanted to do was complain about all of those things to my friend walking with me. But instead I made a choice. I said to my friend, "Anais, praise God for the cold! Praise God for the snow! Praise God for early morning classes!" She looked at me like I was crazy. But something inside of my heart started to change. Joy started filling my heart. Immediately I heard the Lord speak to me in my heart, "Chantelle, the moment you lose the ability to be grateful, is the moment you lose the ability to rejoice." When I made the choice to be grateful for the very things I wanted to complain about, I was given the grace to rejoice and was filled with joy. I encourage you, as we celebrate Thanksgiving and move into the season of Advent, to praise God out loud—even for the things you may want to complain about—and see how God moves in your heart and fills you with joy. He is worthy. "Bless the Lord, o my soul, and all that is within me, bless his holy name!" - Psalm 103:1


