Fr. David's Reflection



This Sunday brings us to the great event of the Transfiguration. St Luke writes that “Jesus took Peter, James, and John his brother, and led them up a high mountain by themselves.” As you know, I was recently on a silent retreat, and this is the verse that the retreat master began the retreat with. He focused on two words that I think are good for us to reflect on as we begin the 2nd full week of Lent. “TOOK & LED”

These 2 simple verbs help to keep, or put things in the proper perspective. We live in a very active culture, we often pride ourselves on how busy our schedules are, and we identify ourselves with the work that we do. This hyper-focus on activity can easily invade our prayer and spiritual life. Especially in Lent, we can get so wrapped up in the practices of penance and prayer that we begin to think that the more I do the holier that I become. Of course, we must respond to God; we are saved by grace, but we will be judged by our response: “faith without works is dead.” But these two verbs remind us that God takes the lead in our salvation. And the Lenten practices that we pick up are done to help us to respond to God’s invitation to return to Him with our whole hearts. Peter, James, and John didn’t go up the mountain on their own initiative, and they didn’t make their own way. They followed Jesus. As we continue in this Lenten season, may we learn to do the same.

Things to do this Lent at Holy Family:

- Join the Book Study with Scott Hahn, register in the Narthex or call the parish office.
- Join us each Friday at 7:00 pm in the Church to pray the Stations of the Cross. *Soup suppers have been cancelled.*
- The family/children’s outdoor Stations of the Cross is after the 9:00 am Mass on Saturday March 25th.
- And on Friday, March 31st, the school students will be leading a special presentation of the Stations of the Cross in the School Gym, cheese pizza will be served.
- Go to confession.
As per our custom, we will have extra times for confession on Monday and Tuesday of Holy Week, with additional confessors available.

[The USCCB has updated the translation of the formula for absolution for the Sacrament of Confession/Reconciliation.](#) So, the next time you go to confession and receive Sacramental Absolution, you may notice a slight variation in the words the priest says. The changes affect the first part of the prayer he says, the actual words of absolution remain the same.

Here is the full prayer:

*“God, the Father of mercies,
through the death and resurrection of his Son
has reconciled the world to himself
and poured out Holy Spirit for the forgiveness
of sins;
through the ministry of the Church
may God grant you pardon and peace.
**And I absolve you from your sins
in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and
of the Holy Spirit.”**
(these words in bold are required for validity)*

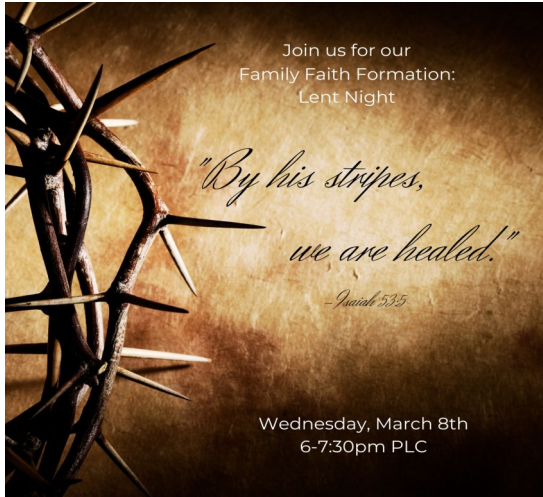
