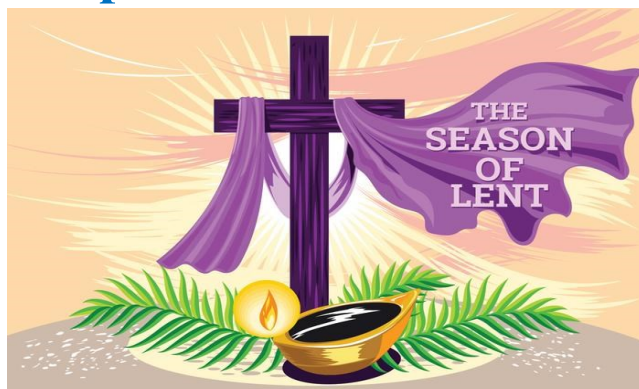

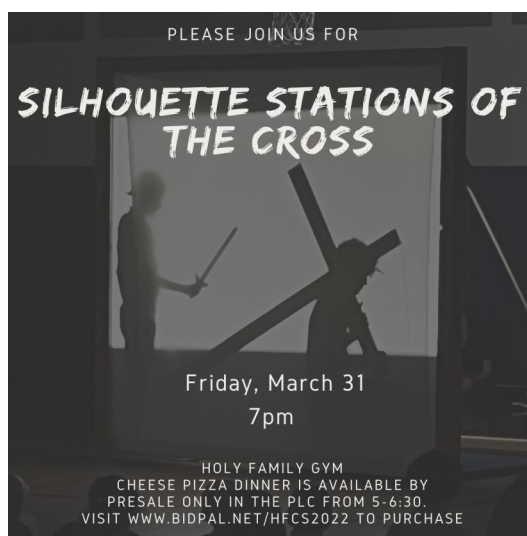
Fr. David's Reflection:

Last week's readings at Mass brought us to the image of water as the sign of life, and this week we are introduced to the image of light. Once we are brought from death to life, then we are brought out of darkness into the marvelous light of truth and grace in Jesus Christ. As our Lenten pilgrimage continues, we should begin to see a little more clearly as our penances help to release us from our earthly attachments and draw us closer to the heart of Jesus.

The readings also shed some light on the Sacraments of the church. [Read this article](#) to see how this weekend's responsorial psalm points to 6 of the 7 Sacraments.

Join us for the Stations of the Cross each Friday at 7:00 pm. On Saturday March 25th, all families are invited to pray the Stations outdoors immediately following the 9:00 am Mass. Gather under the front portico. And on Friday March 31st, we will have a special opportunity to pray the Stations with some of our parish school students and their "live" presentation of the Stations. We will be in the School Gym for this. See flyer below.

Next week we have two special liturgical feasts honoring our parish patrons: Monday we celebrate the Solemnity of St. Joseph, and Saturday we celebrate the Solemnity of the Annunciation to our Lady. For those who desire, you can relax your Lenten practices in honor of these two great feasts!



Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

From Bishop Erik Pohlmeier:

"In whatever form you honor St. Patrick this year during Lent, remember his driving concern was that every soul come to know Christ and the new life he offers because of his death and resurrection. May you grow in the same conviction of faith."



We invite everyone to go to confession, especially during the Season of Lent. As per our custom, we will have extra times for confession on Monday and Tuesday of Holy Week, with additional confessors available.

This week we celebrate Laetare Sunday which is the Latin word for, 'Rejoice'. Similar to Gaudete Sunday in Advent, the name comes from the opening words of the Entrance Antiphon for Mass, "Laetare Jerusalem" which translates to "Rejoice, O Jerusalem". As is fitting, we will begin our masses this weekend with a setting of Psalm 122 beginning with the refrain, "Let us go *rejoicing* to the house of the Lord." Although the instructions in the Roman Missal tell us to refrain from instrumental music during Lent, exceptions include Laetare Sunday. Therefore, you may hear a bit more music than in the previous Lenten Sundays. As throughout Lent, we continue to abstain from singing *Alleluia* and *The Gloria* in Mass, so that when we celebrate Easter, we can sing joyfully sing, "*Alleluia*" and "*Glory to God in the highest*" with exultation!

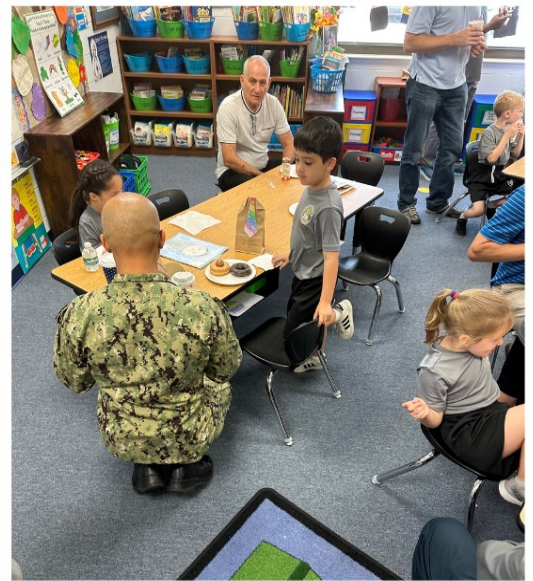

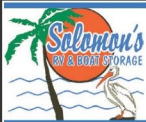
