## Palm Sunday

### Fr. David's Reflection:

This Weekend begins Holy Week, “the Week that Changed the World”. Holy Week stands at the head of our calendar, the holiest week of the entire liturgical year. It celebrates the Paschal Mystery, the passion and death of our Lord, Jesus Christ, and his victorious resurrection, his triumph over sin and death and his glorification by his Father.

Each year our Holy Week Liturgies here at Holy Family are always so well attended. I am continually so impressed by how seriously our parish enters into this Sacred Time; as your pastor, it truly is quite humbling and inspiring.

### Our Schedule:

Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday we will have additional priests on hand to help hear confessions, so if you haven't yet gone to this great Sacrament, please make plans. We will be available from 5:00 - 7:00 pm each of these nights.

### Sacred Triduum:

Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday – no daily Mass these days, please join us for Morning Prayer each day at 9:00 am ([more information](#))

Holy Thursday Mass at 7:00 pm, followed by an opportunity to watch and pray with Jesus in the garden until midnight in the Parish Life Center.

Good Friday reading of the Passion at 3:00 pm with veneration of the Cross; Stations of the Cross at 7:00 pm.

Holy Saturday [THE EASTER VIGIL \(more info\)](#) at 8:30 pm, accompany those in the RCIA as they complete their journey into full communion. If you have never attended this Holy Mass, you should really consider doing so. Yes, it's a little longer, and later, than usual, but it truly is worth it!

An insightful reflection on Holy Week:

It's a wonderful season packed to the brim with meaningful ceremonies that bring us to reflect on the mystery of God's love. Yet we truck from ceremony to ceremony to family lunches and then wrangle over-sugared and overtired children into bed with an exhausted sigh of relief... Is it any wonder that the reverence and wonder of the week is often lost?

Easter can also make us uncomfortable for another reason. In a feel-good culture we don't like to acknowledge our sinfulness. We'd rather believe that our weaknesses are acceptable. But this is the whole point of Christianity. Regardless of how small our sins are, it is the reason that Easter happened. Every - Single - Little - One.

Easter is the time after 40 days, (hopefully) of a new spiritual discipline, to evaluate and meditate on our own imperfections and stand in awe of the radical love of God who died to set us free. It's an awe-inspiring mystery.

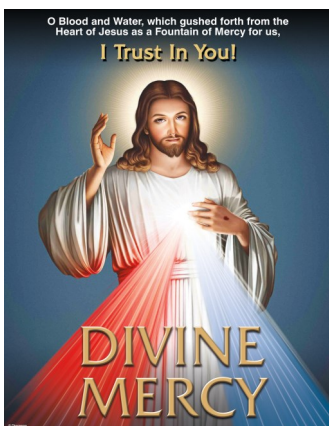

## **Music Ministry**

We begin our Masses with the joyful Entrance Antiphon, *Hosanna to the Son of David*. At the 9:00 am Mass, our Choir will sing the setting by the Renaissance composer Tomas Luis Victoria, and at 11:00 am, our Children's Choir will lead us with *Hosanna!* (by Carol McClure). The Antiphon will be followed by the Entrance Chant, *All Glory Laud and Honor*, the text of which was written around 820 by Theodulph, Bishop of Orleans, while he was imprisoned for plotting against King Louis the Pious. Legend suggests that King Louis passed the prison during a Palm Sunday Procession and heard Theodulph singing this hymn. The story is told that King Louis was so moved, he freed Theodulph and decreed the singing of "All Glory, Laud, and Honor" for all future Palm Sundays. It is widely sung and based on the Gospel read at the Procession, Matthew 21:1-11.

Following the reading of the Passion of our Lord Jesus Christ, the tone drastically changes. Our songs will include the Spiritual, *Were You There When They Crucified My Lord* and *O Sacred Head Surrounded*. The Choir at 9am will sing *Tenabrae Factae Sunt* by Johann Michael Haydn, the brother of Joseph Haydn. This text comes from Matthew 27:47.50 and includes the words, "Jesus cried out in a loud voice, *"Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?"* (which means "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?"). And when Jesus had cried out again in a loud voice, he gave up his spirit.
