Fr. David's Reflection:

He Is Risen - He Is Risen, Indeed!

This traditional Easter greeting shared among Christians recalls the experience of the early Church on the first day of the Resurrection. And it forms the foundation of our belief as disciples of Jesus Christ, for as St. Paul wrote to the Corinthians, we are mere fools if there was no resurrection. And if there is no resurrection then we are still stuck in our sins and we will all perish (1 Cor 15: 12-19). But we know the truth, the reality of the resurrection has been faithfully handed on to us through the apostolic preaching and teaching of Holy Mother Church.

And so I echo to all of you the words of St. Paul from the 2nd reading of Easter Sunday: "If then you were raised with Christ, seek what is above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. Think of what is above, not of what is on earth. For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. When Christ your life appears, then you too will appear with him in glory." (Col 3:1-4).

I also would like to share part of one of the Prefaces that you will hear during the Easter Season. (The Preface is the part of the Mass that comes just before we sing the *Sanctus* (Holy, Holy Holy). It speaks so beautifully of the great mystery we celebrate each day as disciples of Jesus Christ.



Through him the children of light rise to eternal life and the halls of the heavenly Kingdom are thrown open to the faithful; for his Death is our ransom from death, and in his rising the life of all has risen. – Preface II

I pray that you all have a most Blessed Easter! That as you continue to learn what it means to live a hidden life in Christ, that even now you will begin to experience the fullness of the JOY of the glory of the resurrection.

And as we enter into the most holy time of the year, the Sacred Triduum, I share this note from the USCCB,

"The summit of the Liturgical Year is the Easter Triduum—from the evening of Holy Thursday to the evening of Easter Sunday. Though chronologically three days, they are liturgically one day unfolding for us the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery. The single celebration of the Triduum marks the end of the Lenten season, and leads to the Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord at the Easter Vigil."

Here is an article from the <u>St. Paul Center to help us understand the Sacred Triduum</u>, and here is one to assist your family experience of the <u>Sacred Triduum with children</u>.

Music Ministry

Easter: With joyous exultation we once again exclaim, "Alleluia" before the reading of the Holy Gospel. The word Alleluia is the Latin translation of the Hebrew word, Hallelujah. It contains the root, halle, which means 'praise', and 'yah' or 'jah' the Hebrew word for God, Yahweh. On this great Feast of the Resurrection of the Lord, we lift our voices with the highest praise as we celebrate Jesus' victory over death.

After fasting from the Gloria, we can also return to singing it with new exuberance. During Lent, the Church returned to the time of exile remembering the 40 years Moses and the people wandered in the desert. That season of repentance when we reflected on the agony and suffering has come to an end. Today we rejoice because Jesus Christ defeated death. Now we live in the newness of life won by the power and glory of our Savior, Jesus Christ. Therefore, we sing *Glory to God in the Highest*. Let us celebrate with the words from our Responsorial Psalm, *This is the day the Lord has made. Let us rejoice and be glad!* "

I want to thank all our singers and instrumentalists who have devoted many hours to help us to pray the Mass and celebrate the sacred Triduum and Resurrection. At Holy Family, we are blessed with incredibly skilled and talent musicians who lift their hearts in praise with music.




