#### Fr. David's Reflection:

In the 12<sup>th</sup> chapter, St. Paul enjoins the Christians to "rejoice with those who rejoice, weep with those who weep." I think this is an apt description of the journey our parish has been on the past week: the silent sorrow of Good Friday, the glorious excitement of the Resurrection, and the funeral liturgies for Monsignor Danaher gave us the opportunity to live out in real time these words of St. Paul.

I am still trying to find the proper words to describe my impression of the Sacred Triduum liturgies and services. Our parish has always celebrated these solemn events with great numbers and greater devotion. This year was the same, but there was something different. And this is what I am having trouble describing. It was as if a special anointing, a more profound presence of the Holy Spirit was hovering over us.



I offer my sincerest thanks to all of you who take your faith-life so seriously. While we are all on different paths and are at different levels, there is something beautiful happening within our parish, and it is a joy to be able to accompany you through these special times. Thank you for your trust, your prayers, and your support. Let's be Saints!



The Vigil and the Funeral for Msgr. Danaher was a fitting send off for a priest who was loved by so many of the people in our city, so many tears as well as smiles and laughs were shared. Msgr. was a one-of-a-kind, and he will surely be missed by all.

This Sunday completes the Easter Octave: the 8-day-long celebration of Easter! And we get to celebrate the Easter Season for 50 days until Pentecost Sunday May 28. The Octave day of Easter, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Easter, Divine Mercy Sunday all describe the same day on the Liturgical Calendar.



Commenting on the feast of Divine Mercy, Pope Benedict XVI reminded us that "outside the mercy of God there is no other source of hope for human beings." And he encourages us to "accept the gift of peace which the Risen Jesus offers us, let us allow our hearts to be filled with his mercy! In this way, with the power of the Holy Spirit, the Spirit who raised Christ from the dead, we too can bring these Easter gifts to others."

Join us Sunday at 2 for an "hour of Mercy." Our Eucharistic Lord will be exposed for adoration and confessions will be available. At 3:00pm we will sing the Chaplet of Divine Mercy.


