Latest News and Updates

Fr. David's Reflection:

The Gospel this weekend brings us to the famous story about two of the disciples walking to Emmaus on the day of the Resurrection, just 3 days after the Last Supper. This wonderful story told by St. Luke shines a great light on the mystery of the Holy Eucharist and the Holy Mass. The story has 2 main sections which relate to the two main aspects of the Holy Mass: Jesus joins them on their journey and breaks open the Sacred Scriptures and their relation to Him, then during the meal, Jesus is made known to them in the breaking of the bread, (i.e. the Holy Eucharist). Each time we gather for Holy Mass, we share in these disciples' experience: the Word of God is presented to us, firstly in the Sacred Scriptures, and then in the Holy Eucharist. May our encounter with the Risen Lord at Holy Mass compel us to do as those disciples did; may we boldly and joyously share with everyone we encounter the good news that "we have seen the Lord."

You may have noticed that the music we sing at Mass is being introduced differently than in the recent past. Instead of, Processional, Offertory, or Communion, "Hymn" or "Song", you will now hear, Entrance, Offertory and Communion, "Chant". While it may appear that we are changing to new terminology, in actuality, we are returning to the authentic words of the Sacred Mass. This information is outlined in an article which Father David shared with me called, "*Gathering Song*" or "*Entrance Chant*": *What is in a Name?*" written by Father Dylan Schrader. Singing at these times during the Mass is not something we add to the Mass, but it is part of the Mass itself. Therefore, when we introduce, The Entrance Chant, for example, we are identifying an official part of the Mass during which a Sacred action occurs. The word, 'Chant' can be translated from the Latin word, cantus, to the English words, "song" and comes from the Latin word cantare "to sing,". Though we often associate it with Gregorian Chant, it was not attributed to the definition meaning a *Gregorian melody, usually of medieval origin* until 1789. Its first definition according to the Merriam- Webster Dictionary remains, "Song".

The Roman Missal in Latin has never changed the words for The Entrance Chant. Though earlier English editions have included variations, the complete Roman Missal as introduced to the parishes in 2011 contains the authentic terms: Entrance Chant, Offertory Chant and Offertory Chant. Thus, when we sing these parts of the Mass, we are *praying* the Mass as instituted by Mother Church and not merely singing *at* Mass.

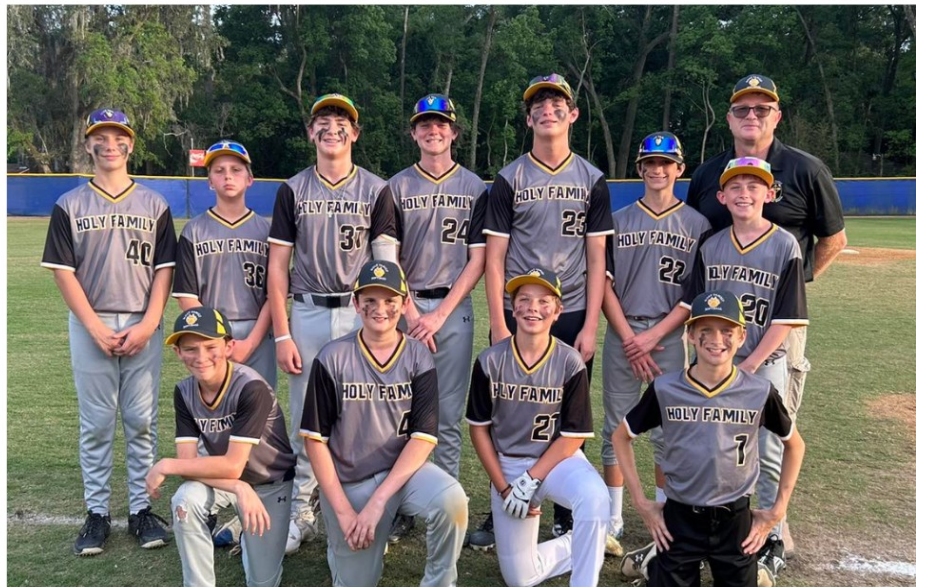

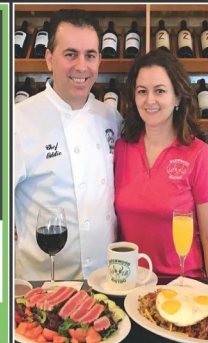
