

Latest News and Updates

Deacon Don's Reflection:



Through today's Gospel, we are unseen witnesses in the Upper Room at the Last Supper. So far, Jesus, Master and Teacher, has lowered Himself to the duty of a slave by washing the feet of His Apostles – an action they do not understand. Then He announces that one of them, one of His chosen ones, would betray Him. After Judas left the Supper for reasons unknown, Jesus announces that before daybreak, Peter, His chosen leader, would actually betray Him. Sensing their confusion and uneasiness, Jesus seeks to calm and reassure them: "Do not let your hearts be troubled. You have faith in God; have faith also in Me." Thus begins the Last Supper Discourse in which Jesus attempts to teach important truths to the men He will leave in charge of His fledgling Church.

One of these vitally important truths is: "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me." Jesus is not "a way"; He is "the way" – the only way to the Father! The word transcribed by the Evangelist for "way" is the word used for roads, both paved and dirt, between cities and villages within the Roman Empire. Jesus was telling them that He is the road, the pathway, to be used to journey to the Father. This divine truth was for the Apostles to understand and to teach, to spread, to all the world. This was their mission. This has become our mission.

St. Peter spread this truth through both his in-person teaching and through his written communication. Today, we hear from his 1st Letter. He implores his audience to "Come to [Jesus], a living stone...and like living stones, let yourselves be built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ." Within our Church, there are two priesthoods: the ordained and the common. Through the Sacrament of Baptism and our sacred anointing, we all become participants in Christ's three-fold office of priest, prophet, and king. Through this common priesthood, we have the ability and the privilege to offer sacrifices to God: sacrifices in the form of prayers, works of mercy,

and other sacrificial acts of kindness, in addition to our daily joys and sufferings. And in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, we have the honor to offer to the Father His only-begotten Son made present through the ministry of His ordained priest.

Remember: at every Mass, following the Preparation of the Gifts, the celebrating priest says to the congregation: "Pray, brethren, that my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God, the almighty Father". His sacrifice and ours! Do we hear? Do we understand? Do we rejoice? We must never, however, forget or minimize the importance of the ordained priesthood. Without them, we don't have the Real Presence of Jesus in our midst or as our sacred Food for our journey. Without them, we don't have the assured forgiveness of our sins. But in the early Church, there was a need for assistants. That is the message of our 1st Reading, believed by many to be the ordination of the first deacons. They were called to serve the Greek speaking members of the infant Church who were being overlooked in the daily distribution of food and other goods. And while waiting on tables may have been their beginning, two of the original seven – Steven and Philip – became known for their preaching. These seven were ordained through the laying on of hands, seen as a transfer of function and the bestowal of power. Yet their function was to serve: serve God, His people, His Church. Today, Permanent Deacons are still ordained to serve. And their service should be a sign for all of God's people of their call to service. As Jesus said: "For the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve." He is our Teacher; we are His students. He demonstrates; we imitate. He leads; we follow.

Music Ministry

Joined with many Catholics across the world, we sing the Anima Christi as a sanctification prayer following Holy Communion. When I came to visit Holy Family Church for the first time, I was blown away by this sung prayer and was fervently moved to find it so that I too could pray this sublime prayer. Here we sing an English musical setting by local Music Minister, Mr. R. Waddell and a Latin setting by Marco Frisina (b. 1954), an Italian Roman Catholic priest and composer. Both texts are available in your pews on a card which also includes the texts for the Latin Mass parts.

The Anima Christi prayer is often associated with St. Ignatius of Loyola (1491–1556), because it was included in his Spiritual Exercises and was clearly a favorite of his. However, it has been found in manuscripts as early as 1370, and Pope John XXII attached indulgences to it in the year 1330. Unquestionably, this profound sacred prayer transcends all time and it can powerfully connect us with Jesus the same today as it did to faithful Christians many centuries ago. One commentor suggested that as we pray the Anima Christi, that we can gaze at the Crucifix and meditate on Jesus at the Cross with each line. 




