



Latest News and Updates

Fr. David's Reflection:

Throughout this Easter Season (Year A), our 2nd reading on Sunday has come from the 1st letter of St. Peter, our first pope. This letter is part of what are referred to as the "catholic epistles." Unlike the letters that are written to a specific church or community, the catholic epistles are addressed to the church as a whole. (We remember that the word catholic means universal). This tradition of writing to the Church at large continues today and is carried on primarily through the Encyclicals of the Holy Father.

This particular letter (1st Peter) is addressed to the Christians who have been scattered throughout the territory due to the persecution suffered by the early Church to remind them that their lives should be marked with hope and joy in the midst of the sufferings they are undergoing for the sake of Christ.

St. Peter expects their lives to be a living testimony to the hope and joy that comes from following Christ, and their testimony should be so obvious that the people they encounter are inquiring about this life. St. Peter exhorts them (and us) to be ready to provide a reason for their hope.

2 questions:

- 1) does your life reflect this Christian Hope?
- 2) are you ready to provide an answer to the questions your life provokes?

NOVENA TO THE HOLY SPIRIT FOR THE SEVEN GIFTS

The novena in honor of the Holy Spirit is the oldest of all novenas since it was first made at the direction of Our Lord Himself when He sent His apostles back to Jerusalem to await the coming of the Holy Spirit on the first Pentecost. It is still the only novena officially prescribed by the Church. Addressed to the Third Person of the Blessed Trinity, it is a powerful plea for the light and strength and love so sorely needed by every Christian. This Novena begins on Friday of the 6th Week of Easter.

Music Ministry

Our responsorial psalm this week comes from Psalm 66, and at most of our Masses we will sing the musical setting by Francesca LaRosa. Psalm 66 - Let All the Earth Cry Out to God - Francesca LaRosa (LIVE with chanted verses) Psalm 66 tells us to sing praise to the glory of His name. It is the second of four Psalms which calls upon the whole earth to praise God. Though in the history of this Psalm, God is known as the God of Israel, he is forever the Creator, King, and Lord of all the earth. Therefore, the whole earth shouts with joy to God! (vs.1) Verse 4 says, " "All the earth will worship You, and will sing praises to You; they will sing praises to Your name." This psalm correlates with our Readings during the Easter season which proclaim how the Good News is spread to the Gentiles. Thus, all the earth and not just the Israelites sing of God's glory. This week, we will sing the hymn, All Creatures of our God and King, which beautifully expresses the theme of all the earth praising God. All Creatures of Our God and King (Tune: Lasst uns Erfreuen - 4vv) [with lyrics for congregations] The sentiment is culminated with the final verse, Let all things their Creator bless, and worship God in humbleness. We will also sing, Jubilate Alleluia, a Taize setting of Psalm 66, Jubilate, Alleluia. The refrain sung in Latin, Jubilate deo omnis terra, is the response from today's psalm and translates to, Shout to God with joy, all peoples of the earth. At the 9:00 am Mass, the Adult Choir will sing, If You Love Me, by John Ness Beck. The text for this anthem comes from today's Gospel reading from St. John, "If you love me, keep my commandments" (John 14:15)






