

Latest News and Updates

Fr. David's Reflection:



This weekend brings us to the penultimate Sunday of the Easter Season as we celebrate the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord. Technically this festival happened this past Thursday which marks the 40th day after the Resurrection, and many places still celebrate this feast on that day. Most of the Bishops in the U.S. have decreed that it be transferred to the 7th Sunday of Easter (here are the proper readings).

The Ascension completes the Paschal Mystery: Jesus' life, passion, death and resurrection, and it is the final step before the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. The Catechism of the Catholic Church states: "Jesus' final apparition ends with the irreversible entry of his humanity into divine glory, symbolized by the cloud and by heaven, where he is seated from that time forward at God's right hand" (No. 659).

"Christ's Ascension means that he no longer belongs to the world of corruption and death that conditions our life. It means that he belongs entirely to God. He, the Eternal Son, led our human existence into God's presence, taking with him flesh and blood in a transfigured form. ... the Ascension of the Lord means that Christ has not departed from us, but that he is now, thanks to his being with the Father, close to each one of us forever. Each one of us can be on intimate terms with him; each can call upon him."

- Pope Benedict XVI

We continue with the <u>Novena to the Holy Spirit</u> in preparation of next Sunday's celebration of Pentecost.

After all the Masses this weekend, the youth outreach will be having a bake sale to help offset the cost of their summer trip to the Steubenville Youth Conference in Orlando. The total cost for each youth is \$350. They will greatly appreciate the financial support.

Please keep our 8th graders in your prayers as they prepare for graduation on June 1st. Mass is at 5pm.

The 2023 Florida Eucharistic Congress is coming soon. Friday June 9 in Gainesville, and Saturday June 10 at St. Joseph's parish in Mandarin. This is always an exciting event, and it promises to deepen your faith in the Holy Eucharist. ON SATURDAY JUNE 10, there will be no 9:00 am morning Mass or confessions, both will be available at the Congress. Make plans to attend.



Beginning Monday June 5th, our church will be undergoing a much-needed face lift as we get a new roof, gutters and a fresh coat of paint. The project is expected to take 6 weeks to complete. During that time, daily Mass will be held in the Parish Life Center, Sunday Mass will be in the Church. This will allow for longer workdays and a quieter celebration of the Holy Mass. Music Ministry

Our Choir will sing, *Cantate Domino*, by Giuseppe Pitoni (1657-1743). The Latin text comes from Psalm 149:1-2 and translates to the following:

Sing to the Lord a new song, his praise in the assembly of the saints.

Let Israel rejoice in He who made them, and the people of Zion rejoice in their King.

The Bible has over 400 references to singing and 50 direct commands to sing. Twice in the New Testament, we are told to sing. In Colossians 3:16 St. Paul tells us that we are told, let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs with thankfulness in your hearts to God. In St. Paul's letter to the Ephesians, he instructs us, be filled with the Spirit, addressing one another with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and playing to the Lord in your hearts, (Ephesians 5:19-20) Our singing is a direct consequence of being filled with the Holy Spirit. Our praise does not come from the music itself nor from the words but must be an outpouring of our hearts. This is further illustrated in Psalm 28 in which the Psalmist praises God with song as a consequence. Verse 7 tells us, The LORD is my strength and my shield, in whom my heart trusts. I am helped, so my heart rejoices; with my song I praise him.

Profound revelation comes to us from Zephaniah 3:17 that not only does God tell us to sing, but that he, the Lord of the Universe sings over us! This verse tells us that God rejoices over us and exults in us with loud singing. Also, there are many references to Jesus himself singing including Matthew 26:30, Hebrews 2:12a, and Psalm 22:22. What a joy and honor it is to lift our hearts and voices at Mass as we celebrate the Ascension of our Lord! Sing to the LORD a new song; sing to the LORD, all the earth. Sing to the LORD, praise his name; proclaim his salvation day after day. (Psalm 96: 1-2)
