





### Fr. David's Reflection:



The Most Holy Trinity: from the Catechism of the Catholic Church (234)" The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them." As we find in the Athanasius Creed: "the Father is God, the Son is God, and the Holy Spirit is God, and yet there are not three Gods but one God."



### June – the Month of the Sacred Heart

No matter what the mainstream media, our favorite big box store, national beer company, a major league sports team, or your social media feed are telling us: the image of the Sacred Heart is THE image of true love. Yes, love does win, but love does not promote or endorse sin, love is found in self-denial and self-gift, not in a militant insistence on self-acceptance, promotion and gratification. And love cannot be separated from the truth. There can be no love outside of the Truth, as sacred scripture reminds us: *God is Love* (1 Jn 4:16) & *I am the Truth* (Jn 14:6). Pope Benedict XVI dedicated one of his encyclicals to this topic. Caritas en Veritate (Charity in Truth).

Let us remember the words of Jesus: "learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart (Matt 11:29), and that <u>pride is one of the 7 Deadly Sins</u>, it should not be celebrated.

Next week we celebrate Corpus Christi and then follows the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. As the lives of countless saints reveal, when we encounter this truth, the Love of Jesus found in the Eucharist and in His Sacred Heart, our lives will be radically changed, and then we will be able to be effective witness to the world of True Love. Perhaps our failure to follow the command to love just as God loves is one of the reasons why we are being bombarded with endless counterfeit forms of love.



### **Music Ministry**

At our 9:00 am Mass, the Choir will sing a setting of Of the Father's Love Begotten, a hymn written around the year 400 by Aurelius Clemens Prudentius and later translated by John Mason Neale. This is particularly fitting for our Masses this weekend because it was written to defend and fight for what we believe and celebrate as The Holy Trinity. Prudentius (348-c. 413) was a prominent lawyer and judge who began writing poetry at age 57 because he wanted to make more meaning of his life. Interestingly, he used his legal skills to fight against the heretics, and this hymn written 16 centuries ago is the fruit of this work. Attacks against Christianity included ones from Arius (c. 250-336), who said that God the Father and the Son did not co-exist throughout eternity. This heresy stated that Jesus was created before his incarnation and that he was not equal to God the Father. Prudentius defends against that heresy right from the first line and title, "Of the Father's love begotten" which was translated from the Latin words, "Corde natus ex parentis ante mundi exordium". Literally, it means "Born from the parent's heart before the beginning of worlds" As we sing or listen to this ancient hymn, it can have deeper meaning if we contemplate its purpose of teaching the truth of the Holy Trinity that God the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit have always co-existed and will for evermore. A few of the nine verses are included below.


"Of the Father's love begotten, Ere the worlds began to be, He is Alpha and Omega, He the source, the ending he Of the things that are, that have been And that future years shall see, Evermore and evermore."

This is He Whom seers in old time Chanted of with one accord; Whom the voices of the prophets Promised in their faithful word; Now He shines, the long expected, Let creation praise its Lord, Evermore and evermore!

O ye heights of heaven adore Him; Angel hosts, His praises sing; Powers, dominions, bow before Him, and extol our God and King! Let no tongue on earth be silent, Every voice in concert sing, Evermore and evermore!

Christ, to Thee with God the Father, And, O Holy Ghost, to Thee, Hymn and chant with high thanksgiving, And unwearied praises be: Honour, glory, and dominion, And eternal victory, Evermore and evermore!


