Latest News and Updates

Fr. David's Reflection:

O Sacrament Most Holy, O Sacrament Divine, All Praise and All Thanksgiving be every moment thine.

We celebrate another great Solemnity this weekend, Corpus Christi, the Body and Blood of Jesus, as we turn our gaze on to the real presence of Jesus in the Most Holy Eucharist. [The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches](#) us that The Eucharist is the memorial of Christ's Passover, that is, of the work of salvation accomplished by the life, death, and resurrection of Christ, a work made present by the liturgical action. And that it is Christ himself, the eternal high priest of the New Covenant who, acting through the ministry of the priests, offers the Eucharistic sacrifice. And it is the same Christ, really present under the species of bread and wine, who is the offering of the Eucharistic sacrifice.

The U.S. Bishop's Conference has launched a 3-year "[Eucharistic Revival](#)" to help shine the light on the "SOURCE AND SUMMIT" of our faith. The bishops have done this in response to a national survey that revealed only 30% of Catholics believe as the Church teaches: that what Jesus said at the Last Supper is true, the Eucharist is His body and blood, and without the Eucharist we have no life. I would like to think that our parish has a higher percentage of belief, but I know that a good number of our registered parishioners don't attend Mass weekly, and many who do attend come late and leave early, so I wonder sometimes. What can we do to address this? Send us a note; I would love to get your feedback.

This weekend is our diocesan Eucharistic Congress. We will not have Saturday morning Mass or confessions this weekend so that everyone can attend the Congress at St. Josephs parish in Mandarin. I hope to see you there.

 2. Jesus has remained within the Eucharist for love... of you. He has remained, knowing how men would treat him... and how you would treat him. He has remained so that you could eat him, so that you could visit him and tell him what's happening to you; and so that you could talk to him as you pray beside the Tabernacle, and as you receive him sacramentally; and so that you could fall in love more and more each day, and make other souls, many souls, follow the same path. (The Forge, 887)
 3. The humility of Jesus: in Bethlehem, in Nazareth, on Calvary. But more humiliation and more self-abasement still in the Sacred Host: more than in the stable, more than in Nazareth, more than on the Cross. That is why I must love the Mass so much. (The Way, n. 533).

Music Ministry

For the Feast of Corpus Christi, there is no hymn more known nor more appropriate than Panis Angelicus. 'Panis Angelicus' or "Bread of Angels" comes from the hymn 'Sacris solemniis', which was written by Saint Thomas Aquinas for the Feast of Corpus Christi in the 13th century. Separated from the larger work, the verse we know as 'Panis Angelicus' has been set to music by many composers. Probably the most well-known is the setting by César Franck who wrote it as part of his *Messe à trois voix* around 1861. In addition to Franck's *Panis Angelicus*, our Adult Choir will also sing Mozart's *Ave Verum* at the 11:00 am Mass. The lyrics and translations to both are below. Also composed for the Feast of Corpus Christi, Mozart composed this setting in 1791 for Anton Stoll, a friend who was the church musician of St. Stephan in Baden bei Wien. Many other composers have written music for "Ave verum corpus" which is a short Eucharistic chant which dates back to the 13th century. During the Middle Ages it was sung at the elevation of the Eucharist during the consecration at Mass and also during Sacrament. It is a meditative prayer on the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.

This weekend is the last Mass at which the Choir will sing until fall. Thank you, Choir members for sharing your time, talents, hard work and friendship. It has been an honor and joy to serve with you, and I cannot wait to begin again in September! In addition, this weekend we bid farewell and offer thanks to Andrew and Erica Zdeb who have beautifully and generously shared their talents as violinist and cantor with us at Holy Family. Please join us in praying for Andrew and Erica as they begin a new journey. They will be missed!

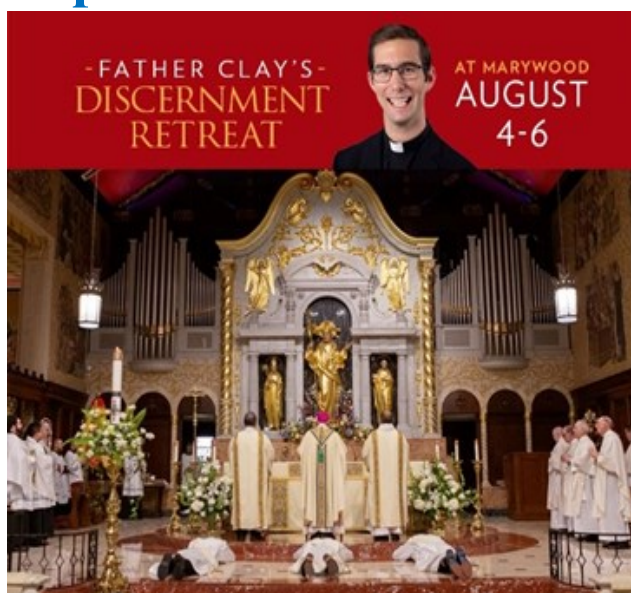

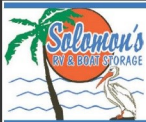
