

Latest News and Updates

Fr. David's Reflection:

During this long weekend many of us will begin to celebrate Independence Day, and we will remember all the sacrifices that have been made for us to be able to live in this great country. Our nation was founded on the principles of life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness that are endowed to us by our creator, not granted us by the government. All those years ago, so many men fought for and died for the freedoms that we so often take for granted. They did this because they believed in higher principles that often demand sacrifice. It's sad that so many seem to have forgotten this, even our leaders.

In your celebrations, please take time to pray for our country, for the repentance and conversion of our leaders, for a return to the primacy of natural law, and for the strengthening of families.

At Holy Mass, we continue to listen to St. Paul's letter to the Romans as the second reading. This weekend we are introduced to Paul's teaching on baptism: in baptism we die to this world and the life of sin, and in exchange we are raised into new life in Christ Jesus. As we live this new life in Christ, we must allow God's grace to radically reorient our lives. And this new life places upon us responsibilities and duties that go beyond our immediate needs and wants. This is why in the Gospel passage Jesus says that our devotion to Him even comes before our allegiance to our family. As we know from the first commandment, God says that nothing should come before Him. For the sake of the Gospel, we must take up our cross and be willing to lay down everything, even our own life.


To help us fulfill our duties and responsibilities Holy Mother Church gives us the 5 precepts as the bare minimum requirements to be considered a practicing Catholic. The 5 are:

- 1) "You shall attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation and rest from servile labor."
- 2) "You shall confess your sins at least once a year."
- 3) "You shall receive the sacrament of the Eucharist at least during the Easter season."
- 4) "You shall observe the days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church."
- 5) "You shall help to provide for the needs of the Church.

Last week Fr. Pine shared with us about confession, here he is with a slightly longer video of a conversation about when we should be receiving Holy Communion. It's probably not a question we spend enough time thinking about. These priests touch on a few topics that are worth pondering.

Music Ministry



Above the organ in our Sanctuary, we have a beautiful picture of St. Cecelia, the Patron Saint of music and musicians. The original was painted by Giovanni Francesco Barbieri (1591-1666), an Italian Renaissance painter known as Guercino, who is best known for his religious artwork and depictions of Biblical figures. St. Cecelia has appeared in countless works of art and is often seen with a viola or organ as an illustration of the important role of music in the Holy Mass and her connection to music. Her life, however, preceded the organ in the painting. According to The Acts of St. Cecelia from the 5th century, St. Cecilia was born in the 3rd century to a noble family in the Roman Empire. As a young child, she took a vow of chastity, but she was forced by her parents to marry a noble pagan named, Valerian. It is said that she "sang in her heart to the Lord" as the musicians played at her wedding. The legend continues that she told her husband of her vow and that she had angels guarding her purity. Her husband told her he would respect her vow if he saw the angel. St. Cecelia told him that he would first need to be baptized by Pope Urbanus. Both Valerian and his brother, Tibertius were converted, and saw the angel after their baptism. They devoted their lives to illegally burying saints who had been persecuted and martyred for their faith. When they refused to give sacrifice to pagan gods, both brothers were also martyred for their faith. After the death of her husband and brother-in-law, St. Cecelia divided her possessions among the poor and converted hundreds of pagans. Almachius, the Prefect of the city, ordered her death, but she survived persecution and torture and lived through the first attempt where she was subjected to fire and intense heat. At the second attempt, she was struck three times by the sword in her neck, but the executioner could not kill her, and she survived for several days. During her final days, it is said that Saint Cecilia asked that her house become a Church which is now the Church of Santa Cecilia in Trastevere where her remains are found. In 1599, her body was exhumed and found her to be incorrupt.

As we sing the Mass for the Glory of God here at Holy Family, St. Cecelia, pray for us.


