Latest News and Updates

Fr. David's Reflection:

"for my house shall be called a house of prayer for all peoples." (Is 56:7)

In the readings for last Sunday's Mass, we saw how important and necessary it is to train ourselves to be able to perceive the voice of the Lord amid the various distractions we all face each day. And in today's first reading, the prophet Isaiah makes a beautiful connection between our personal prayer and our liturgical/public prayer. The prophet Isaiah reminds us that God desires that His house should be a house of prayer for all people. So, first, we know that everyone is welcome to worship/pray with us (although not everyone can receive Holy Communion) Second, we know that out of Christian charity we have a duty to help one another be able to encounter God when they are with us for the Sacrifice of the Holy Mass. One of the ways that we do this is by helping to create an atmosphere within the church that is conducive to a prayerful encounter. I mentioned last week that the Church prescribes and expects that there be silence in and around the church during the moments proceeding Mass, and even at times during the Mass. Because the Church has long known and taught that silence is necessary in order to establish a stable and effective prayer life, I want to thank everyone once again for helping to create a reverent atmosphere inside the church as you prepare for Mass; it's a beautiful sign of respect for the sacred space of our parish church and for the people who come here to encounter Jesus. Of all the many compliments that we receive from guests and visitors, the reverence and devotion that is shown is always among the top, as is the friendliness and welcoming attitude that you all show to them. You are proof that it is possible to do both -- to be quiet and reverent and to be friendly and welcoming -- and to do them well. Thank you for helping to bring Isaiah's words to life at Holy Family Catholic Church and School: we do have a house of prayer for all peoples.


