

### **Latest News and Updates**

#### Fr. David's Reflection:

In last Sunday's Gospel, Simon made a profound declaration of faith as he properly identified Jesus as the "the Messiah, the Son of the living God". It was a moment of unique importance as it led to the changing of his name and the foundation of the papacy and the Church. The passage from Matthew 16 continues this weekend, but it takes a little turn. As Jesus reveals the necessity of his upcoming passion death, and resurrection, Peter attempts to thwart the Will of God by imposing his own ideas and understanding. Jesus immediately rebukes him for thinking as man does and not as God does.

I think we can all agree how necessary it is for the pope to think with the mind of God, and I hope that we can see that same obligation is placed upon us all. We each must allow ourselves to be transformed by the Gospel while resisting the temptation to conform to the lies of the world.

Someone recently put out a list of truths that have always been held firmly by the Church but as of late have been called into question. I share a somewhat modified version of that list. It serves as a good point of reflection and as a litmus test: have our minds be transformed by the Gospel, or have we allowed our views to be corrupted by the word?

- The Church: Christ established One Church—the Catholic Church—and, therefore, only the Catholic Church provides the fullness of Christ's truth and the authentic path to His salvation for all of us.
- The Sacraments: The Eucharist and all the sacraments are divinely instituted, not developed by man. The Eucharist is truly Christ's Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity, and to receive Him in Communion unworthily (i.e. in a state of grave, unrepentant sin) is a devastating sacrilege for the individual and for the Church. (1 Cor 11:27-29)
- Marriage: God has established marriage as between one man and one woman faithful to each other for life and open to children. Humanity has no right or true ability to redefine marriage. Sexual activity outside marriage is always gravely sinful and cannot ever be condoned, blessed, or deemed permissible.
- Repentance/Confession: Jesus says we must "deny ourselves, take up our cross and follow Him.") Through repentance and sacramental confession, every battle with temptation and sin can be a small victory that leads us to embrace the great victory that Christ has won for us.
- **Identity**: Each one of us is created in the image and likeness of God: male or female, and no one has the right to reject their biological and God-given identity.

It is first Sunday this weekend, as is our custom, 9:00 am Mass will conclude with a brief period of Eucharistic Exposition and Benediction. [you will notice that priest's hands are covered by a veil during the Benediction (the blessing with the monstrance). This is because a priest's hands are consecrated, and he has the power to bless in the name of Jesus, so they are covered because in Eucharistic Benediction, it is God Himself, in the Eucharist, who is imparting the Blessing)

Join us for coffee and donuts after the 7:00 am and 9:00 am Masses. All families are invited to a "play date" on the school playground after the 9am Mass, grab a donut and come meet some new friends. You can enter through a gate on the right side of the school.

### **Wildcat Sports Are Back!**








