



Latest News and Updates

Fr. David's Reflection:

As we enter into the month of October, I want to focus our attention on a few of the things that the Church presents to us this month.

Firstly, this month is dedicated as Respect Life Month. While there are many different aspects of this outreach, there are two that I will highlight.

The inviable dignity and worth of every human life – which faces its greatest threat through the diabolical practice of abortion. Never be fooled by the political slogan that hides this evil as a "choice." It is the intentional and direct killing of an innocent life; it is always and everywhere wrong to participate in an abortion in any way. There are many resources and organizations in our community that offer help to pregnant women who are in need. Click here. And there are resources available for any woman or man who has participated in an abortion and are in need of healing. Click here. Please don't hesitate to reach out. For further information please read The Gospel of Life from St. John Paul II.

Healthy Marriages – since the Garden of Eden, the devil has been attacking marriages, and we all know the assault that marriage as an institution has been under in our country and in the West for the last century primarily from legalized birth control and no-fault divorce. If it were not for these 2 issues, we probably would not be in the mess we are in today. But here we are, and I know this is one area where so many people suffer silently. But we must not lose hope or give in to fear. We must pray tirelessly for all marriages: for strength, for healing, and for reconciliation. As a parish family, we should be a place of hope and of healing. If you are interested in helping to form a ministry/outreach to assist married couples, please reach out to me.

And secondly, October is the "Month of the Rosary", as we celebrate the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary on October 7th. Do you know the history of this feast (click here and here)? It marks the "the greatest naval victory since Pharaoh's army drowned in the Red Sea," as Pope Pius V called for the whole church to pray the rosary, imploring Our Blessed Mother assistance as the "Holy League" faced the much larger Ottoman Empire. The Ottoman Empire was defeated and Western Society and Culture were saved from certain oblivion. Throughout the centuries the Blessed Mother has proven to be a most-powerful intercessor in the battles that we face, whether physical or spiritual. If you have not yet done so, I strongly encourage you and your family to adopt the practice of praying the rosary each day. Here is a link on how to pray the rosary?


Millions of Monicas


