



Latest News and Updates

Fr. David's Reflection:

The readings this weekend remind us of the great wedding banquet feast that we have all been invited to. Ultimately, that feast will be experienced in heaven, but as disciples of Jesus and members of His body, we don't have to wait until then. The new life in the kingdom that Jesus promises can be experienced even now, and we certainly get a foretaste of this wedding banquet each time we participate worthily at the Holy Mass. This is why it is crucial for us to prepare well for the Holy Mass each time we come.

I think many of us have heard the phrase "familiarity breeds contempt" which points out that when we get comfortable with something, we often times will lose our sense of awe and wonder. I think that there is great possibility of this happening to us as it relates to the Holy Mass. While we may not have actual contempt for the Holy Mass, can we say that we are overcome with awe and wonder (aka fear of the Lord) each time we go to Mass? When we attend the Holy Mass, are we really aware that we are in the presence of the Living God (click here) and do we truly expect to have a life-changing encounter with Him, His Word, and His Sacrament? And does the way we prepare, the way we dress, and the way we act inside of the Church help to foster this expectation? Or does it hinder it? And are we aware of the influence, good or bad, that we have on our neighbors?

There are many prayers that we can use to help prepare. here are some examples. More prep tips here

At the end of this weekend's Gospel, a man is kicked out of the banquet (the kingdom) and not allowed to celebrate because of the way he was dressed. Now, there is more meaning to this passage than simply failing to meet the dress code, but we cannot discount this aspect completely. There is lots of information out there about how one should or should not dress for Mass. Here are a few videos that address the topic of dressing appropriately for Holy Mass click here and here and here.

Did you know that the Church provides prayers for the priest as he is vesting to help him prepare for Holy Mass? Maybe they can serve as a basis for your own personal prayers as you get dressed for Holy Mass.

VESTING PRAYERS FOR PRIESTS

While he washes his hands Give strength to my hands, Lord, to wipe away all stain, so that I may be able to serve Thee in purity of mind and body.

As he places the Amice over his head Lord, set the helmet of salvation on my head to fend off all the assaults of the devil.

As he puts on the Alb Purify me, Lord, and cleanse my heart so that, washed in the Blood of the Lamb, I may enjoy eternal bliss.

As he ties the Cincture Lord, gird me with the cincture of purity and extinguish my fleshly desires, that the virtue of continence and chastity may abide within me.

As he puts the Stole around his neck Lord, restore the stole of immortality, which I lost through the collusion of our first parents, and, unworthy as I am to approach Thy sacred mysteries, may I yet gain eternal joy.

As he puts on the Chasuble O Lord, who has said, 'My yoke is sweet and My burden light,' grant that I may so carry it as to merit Thy grace.

The music comes from a theme in Gustav Holst's Orchestral Suite, "Planets", written between 1914 and 1917 which he later adapted to fit the text of the patriotic song, "I Vow to Thee, My Country." The text was written by Michael A. Perry, an Anglican Priest, who was an influential hymn writer and author of many Biblical studies. Perry said he wrote the words to *All God beyond All Praising*, "in response to a call for alternative words that would be more appropriate for Christian worship." Indeed, the words are full of praise and worship which are very fitting way to lift our heart, minds, and voices to God at the start of the Holy Mass.
