## Fr. David's Reflection,

As we come to the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of this Advent Season, we celebrate Gaudete "Rejoice" Sunday, which comes from the entrance antiphon from Philippians 4:5, "Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, rejoice. Indeed, the Lord is near." St. Paul's exhortation reminds us to keep our heads up and looking out for the promised Messiah. The Messiah is near which is why we can, and should, be rejoicing. There is no promise of an easy life, or that all our problems will go away... the promise is that Jesus, Emmanuel, will always be with us. And because of this, we are filled with joy.

The preface of the Mass (the first part of the Eucharistic prayer) also brings to mind this reality as we pray, *"for all the oracles of the prophets foretold him, the Virgin Mother longed for him with love beyond all telling, John the Baptist sang of his coming and proclaimed his presence when he came. It is by his gift that already we rejoice at the mystery of his Nativity, so that he may find us watchful in prayer and exultant in his praise."*

The nearness of the arrival of the Messiah is also proclaimed through the singing of the "O Antiphons" which begins on December 17<sup>th</sup> and go through the 24<sup>th</sup>. These antiphons are the source of the traditional version of O Come O Come Emmanuel: each title comes from these Antiphons.

"The *O Antiphons* are seven precious jewels of our Catholic Liturgy, counting down the last seven days before Christmas with building anticipation. The title *O Antiphons* is simply because each phrase begins with an "O."

Dating back to the fourth century, these antiphons address Christ with seven magnificent Messianic titles: *O Sapientia* (Wisdom), *O Adonai* (Lord and Ruler), *O Radix Jesse* (Root of Jesse), *O Clavis David* (Key of David), *O Oriens* (Dawn of the East), *O Rex Gentium* (King of the Gentiles), and *O Emmanuel* (God With Us) based on the Old Testament prophecies and types of Christ. Put in reverse order: *Emmanuel*, *Rex*, *Oriens*, *Clavis*, *Radix*, *Adonai*, and *Sapientia*, the first letters of these Messianic titles spell out the Latin words **ERO CRAS**, meaning, "Tomorrow, I will come." The antiphons sum up in excellence the longing of our Redeemer, and we echo the prayers of the Old Testament faithful by also begging Him to "Come!" In addition, our Children's Choir will be singing *Come, Lord Jesus* and *Veni Jesu Amor Mi* (Come Jesus my love) at the 11am Mass. The word "*gaudete*" is derived from the Latin words "*gaudium*," joy, and "*gaudeo*," to rejoice or be glad. *Gaudete* is taken from the Entrance Antiphon given to us on the third Sunday of Advent: "Rejoice in the Lord always; again, I say, rejoice. Indeed, the Lord is near". Our First and Second readings as well as the Responsorial Psalm all contain the word, "rejoice". As we draw nearer to Christmas, we wait in joyful expectation!

It serves over 3,000 underprivileged girls, giving them new hope and perspective on life.
