



General Information

Fr. David's Reflection,

On behalf of Fr. Prabhu, Mr. Kavanagh, School Principal, and the entire Holy Family Catholic Church and School Community, I wish you all a very blessed and merry Christmas. As we celebrate the birth of our savior, the Prince of Peace, let us keep in mind all those areas in the world that are torn by strife, war, and division. At the time of Jesus' birth, the earth was shrouded in darkness, I pray that the light of Christ may reign in every heart and every home. I am looking forward to seeing everyone at Mass as we celebrate the greatest gift of all, Jesus Christ our Lord.



Like many of you, I have allowed myself to be distracted this week by the headlines surrounding a document that was released by Pope Francis and the Vatican on Monday. The document entitled *Fiducia Supplicans* (On the Pastoral Meaning of Blessings) caused quite a stir as many in the media rushed to tell the world that Pope Francis is now allowing priests to bless same-sex marriages and irregular unions (i.e., divorced and remarried couples/cohabitating couples). This is far from the truth and intentionally misleading. I strongly suggest everyone read the declaration for yourself and not rely on the interpretations of those who seem to delight in fermenting chaos and division as they undermine the Church and Her teachings. The document was written to clarify the distinction between liturgical and pastoral blessings; and it clearly upholds the truth about marriage - the union of one man and one woman who are bound together for life and open to natural means of procreation. Anything other than that is not marriage, and the Church cannot recognize it as such.

We are all sinners in need of God's grace and blessing. But as we know, the Church cannot bless sin. So, when someone requests a non-liturgical blessing, it is assumed that the person, in some way, is already oriented toward the Truth, and is desiring to

live according to God's will and the teachings of Holy Mother Church. The blessing is given as an aid to this desire and not as an endorsement of any sinful lifestyle choices.

It is sad that so much time has been spent this week discussing this; we are so close to the celebration of the Nativity of our Lord. Let us, in these remaining days and hours, quiet our minds and our hearts and prepare the "manger of our hearts" to receive our Savior and Our Lord.

"We wish to make it clear that departure from the Church's teaching, or silence about it, in an effort to provide pastoral care is neither caring nor pastoral. Only what is true can ultimately be pastoral." – Joseph Cardinal Ratzinger (Pope Benedict XVI)


