The Season of Lent begins next week; Ash Wednesday is February 14th and is a day of fast and abstinence. "Lent is the forty-day liturgical season of fasting, special prayer, and almsgiving in preparation for Easter. The name "Lent" is from the Middle English "Lencten," meaning spring... The number "forty" is first noted in the Canons of Nicaea (A.D. 325), likely in imitation of Jesus' fast in the desert before [click here for more info and links from SimplyCatholic](#).

Are you looking for a way to draw closer to Jesus this Lent? For years many people have chosen to allow Mary to help them deepen their faith life and to bring them to her Son through a devotion called [Total Consecration to Jesus through Mary \(click for more info\)](#). You are invited to participate in this time-honored and beloved devotion on Monday March 25th. There will be a communal celebration of the Consecration on Monday March 25th, both after the 9:00 am Mass, and again at 7:00 pm.

You can purchase the book yourself, or we will have some copies available for sale in the Narthex during the weekend of February 17 & 18.

Music Ministry

As we conclude this short season of Ordinary Time continue to sing the Mass of St. Philip Neri found in the Source and Summit Missals beginning on page 45 with #18.

At 11:00 am, our Adult Choir will sing, *O Taste and See*, by Ralph Vaughn Williams (1872-1958). It is a beautiful motet composed in 1953 for the coronation of Elizabeth II. The text is simply verse 8 of Psalm 34: *O taste and see how gracious the Lord is: blessed is the man that trusteth in him*.

We will also sing, *All Glory is Yours* by Bob Moore. The words to the refrain begin "To you, O God, all glory be, all glory forever" which compliments this week's 2nd reading in which St. Paul says, "...whatever you do, do everything for the glory of God."

As we go forth from our masses, we will sing, *Holy God We Praise Thy Name*. The lyrics to this much-loved hymn were written in 1771 by a German Catholic Priest named, Ignaz Franz. They are based on the *Te Deum*, a Latin hymn which originated in the fourth century. The name comes from the incipit, or first words, of the hymn, *Te Deum laudamus*, which is Latin for 'Thee, O God, we praise'.

With joy, let us celebrate with the final verse of this week's psalm, "Be glad in the Lord and rejoice, you just; exult, all you upright of heart." (Psalm 32:11).

NOW IS THE PERFECT TIME to join one of our choirs as we prepare for Lent, Holy Week and Easter! We especially need altos, but of course would love more men as well! All highschoolers and adults are welcome. The ability to read music is helpful but not required. Our Children's Choir is for all children both in the Parish and the School. 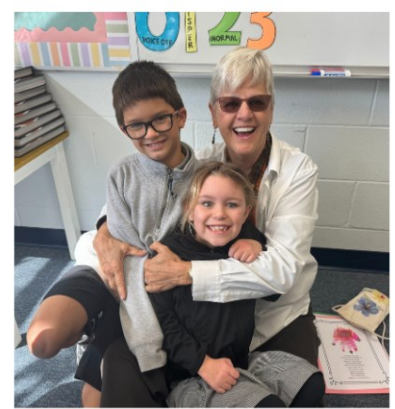
