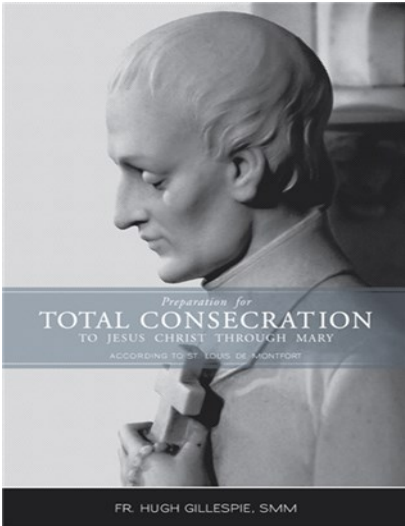

Messages from the Pastor

"For you have given your children a sacred time for the renewing and purifying of their hearts, that, freed from disordered affections, they may so deal with the things of this passing world as to hold rather to the things that eternally endure."

This beautiful prayer is part of Preface II of Lent, one of the options that the priest has when offering the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. As we begin this precious time in the Liturgical life of the Church, I hope that it provides a great framework for each of us to put our hearts and minds in the proper disposition so that we can have a fruitful Lent and a joyful Easter. This Sunday, we hear that Jesus went out to the desert and was tempted by Satan: our lives can be so full, and we can be so attached to the things of this world, that we feel the constant temptation of Satan and we lose perspective of what really matters. May this Lenten season help to purify our hearts and minds so that we can live and love in the manner that God expects for us his children.



Do you want to get closer to Jesus? To align your thoughts, will, and actions with Him? There is no better way to Christ than through His Mother, and the [Total Consecration to Jesus Through Mary \(more info here\)](#).

Music Ministry

You will notice differences in our music during Lent. During Lent we abstain from the word Alleluia in Mass, and we omit the Gloria. Thus, when we celebrate Easter and those words and prayers turn to our Liturgy, we can sing, "Alleluia" and "Glory to God in the Highest" with exultation! Often when we do without something, we have greater appreciation and meaning to what we have missed when it returns. Fasting from music is one way we can prepare for the great joy of celebrating Jesus' Resurrection.

In addition, instruments are only used to accompany singing. We are singing simple Chants for the Eucharistic Acclamations, and we sing Cappella when appropriate. The General Instruction of the Roman Missal states this at no. 313: "In Lent the playing of the organ and musical instruments is allowed only to support the singing. Exceptions are Laetare Sunday (Fourth Sunday of Lent), Solemnities, and Feasts."

NOW IS THE PERFECT TIME to join one of our choirs as we prepare for Lent, Holy Week and Easter! We have an Adult Choir, Men's Schola and a Children's Choir. Adults, we need altos!
