





Messages from the Pastor



Christ is Risen! Happy Easter! With the celebration of the Sacred Triddum (holy 3 days), we come to the end of the great season of Lent and enter into the Season of Easter, a 50-day "retreat" centered on the joy that comes from new life in Christ Jesus. Jesus's resurrection marks the end of the reign of sin and death as the gates of heaven are opened; we now have the certain hope in Eternal Life. "That day" that the ancients longed for has finally arrived, and as baptized members of the Body of Christ we know that "that day" has truly become "this day." We now live in the eternal now of God: so it is right and just that we sing with the angels and saints as we sing "This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad." (Ps 118) On behalf of Fr. Prabhu and the entire staff of Holy Family Catholic Church and School, I pray that you all have a glorious and peaceful Easter Celebration.

As we celebrate the Sacred Triduum and accompany Jesus in real time through the Paschal Mystery, each year on Holy Saturday, Mother Church invites us to meditate on an ancient homily from an unknown source to help us better appreciate the reality of the mystery. Here is an excerpt from that homily:

The Lord descends into hell

"What is happening? Today there is a great silence over the earth, a great silence, and stillness, a great silence because the King sleeps; the earth was in terror and was still, because God slept in the flesh and raised up those who were sleeping from the ages. God has died in the flesh, and the underworld has trembled.

Truly he goes to seek out our first parent like a lost sheep; he wishes to visit those who sit in darkness and in the shadow of death. He goes to free the prisoner Adam and his fellow-prisoner Eve from their pains, he who is God, and Adam's son.

. . .

'I command you: Awake, sleeper, I have not made you to be held a prisoner in the underworld. Arise from the dead; I am the life of the dead. Arise, O man, work of my hands, arise, you who were fashioned in my image. Rise, let us go hence; for you in me and I in you, together we are one undivided person."

<u>Holy Thursday Pilgrimage</u> There is a great tradition practiced throughout the world to help the faithful reflect on the Lord's Passion. And it is growing in popularity in the U.S.: the 7 Churches Visitation on the Night of Holy Thursday in which the faithful go around and visit 7 churches adoring the Lord in the garden/altar of repose. Each church represents a different aspect of the mystery:

- 1) Jesus in the Garden (Lk 22:39-46)
- 3) Jesus before Caiaphas (Mt 26:63-65)
- 5) Jesus before Herod (Lk 23:8-9; 11)
- 7) Jesus's crucifixion and death (Mt 27:27-31)
- 2) Jesus before Annas (Jn 18:19-22)
- 4) Jesus before Pilate (Jn 18:35-37)
- 6) Jesus before Pilate again (Mt 27:22-26)




