

WHICH WORD CAN YOU SEE?

"The shepherds tell one another the reason why they are setting off: 'Let us see this thing that has happened.' Literally the Greek text says: 'Let us see this Word that has occurred there.' Yes indeed, such is the radical newness of this night: the Word can be seen" (Pope Benedict XVI).



We are all familiar with the 12 Days of Christmas, but we might not all be familiar with what that phrase means. We are talking about the period of time from Christmas Day to the Feast of the Epiphany on January 6. The Epiphany is when the Magi (or the Wise Men) came to see the Word made flesh.

But there is another group who came to see him, though they do not get their own feast day. They are the shepherds. Let us not forget that it was not to the wise and learned that Christ first appeared, but rather to the simple and humble, to those whom the world did not consider of much worth.



God loves the little more than the great. He chooses the humble, just as he himself became humble. May we learn this Christmas season to make ourselves little and humble, small enough to hear and even *see* the Word.—Fr. Kevin
