Important Message To Our Parishioners,



We wanted to keep you abreast of our efforts to ensure your safety and instill confidence in returning to Mass.

Two initiatives are being done.

First, we are performing Covid-19 disinfecting and sanitizing by a professional cleaning crew after each Mass and service.

Hospital grade disinfectant is used in the sanctuary to treat the pews. Disinfectant is used to sanitize chairs, doorknobs, and handles. Glass is cleaned of handprints and marks.

The narthex's carpets are vacuumed, and the restrooms are wiped down using a disinfectant.

Second, we have installed iWave air purifiers in the heating/air-conditioning system in the sanctuary.

iWave's Needle Point Bi-Polar Ionization (NPBI) technology is used across diverse environmental conditions, including churches, hospitals, and health care facilities. This technology has shown that 99.4% of Covid-19 (and other viruses) were inactivated in 30 minutes.

It is through the generosity of our parishioners that we have been able to complete this investment. May God continue to bless our parishioners and their families.




THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 5TH AT 10AM AND 7PM


