Shoe Drive NOW - April 30, 2024

St. Isidore Youth Ministry is conducting a shoe drive fundraiser from NOW to April 30th to raise funds for CHWC mission trips. They will earn funds based on the total weight of the pairs of gently worn, used and new shoes collected, as Funds2Orgs will issue a check for the collected shoes. Those dollars will benefit our mission trips. Anyone can help by donating gently worn, used and new shoes at the entrance of Sacred Heart Church or Visitation Church.

All donated shoes will then be redistributed throughout the Funds2Orgs network of micro-enterprise (small business) partners. Funds2Orgsworks with micro-entrepreneurs in helping them create, maintain and grow small businesses in developing countries where economic opportunity and jobs are limited. Proceeds from the sales of the shoes collected in shoe drive fundraisers are used to feed, clothe and house their families. In 2020, we collected 115 bags of shoes (each bag contains 25 pairs of shoes). In 2022, we collected 170 bags of shoes. Thank You!
