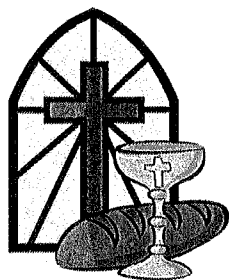
## Eucharist Adoration

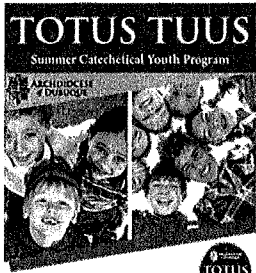
