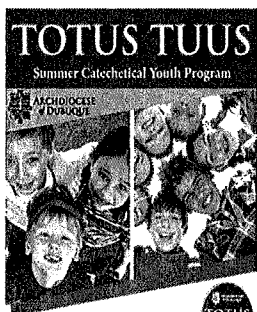
Commission Eucharistic Ministers

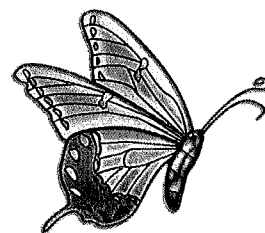
