#### At Sacred Heart

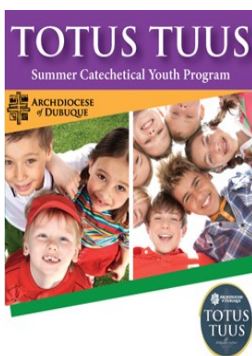
- 1) To Livestream Saturday evening and weekday Masses
