Moving Forward in Faith and Hope

The Archdiocese of Dubuque continues to move forward with its Journey in Faith pastoral planning process. The feedback and data collected from parishes are now being reviewed carefully. This process of discernment will continue through the coming months, with the final pastorate plan and clergy assignments to be announced this spring.

In July 2026, each new pastorate will begin an interim six-month Mass schedule as parishes discern how best to collaborate and flourish as joyful missionary disciples, centered in the Eucharist and united in faith.

Archbishop Thomas Zinkula expresses his gratitude for the ongoing participation and prayer of parishioners, clergy, and staff. He acknowledges that this time of change brings both hope and uncertainty, and he invites all to continue praying for one another and for the guidance of the Holy Spirit.
