The final pastorate plan and priest assignments will be announced this spring.

Beginning in July 2026, each new pastorate will begin with an interim six-month Mass schedule as parishes prayerfully discern how to work together in mission, unity, and love. The Archdiocese is also developing resources to help with parish collaboration, evangelization, and renewal.
