St. Mary's Mission has been a staple at the Red Lake Indian Reservation for over a century. They are the longest standing Christian presence there. The local people know that this mission is very generous to the needs of the people, having a long-established school that is ever improving and a church where all are welcome.

The new church, which replaced the church that was destroyed by fire, is a testament to the commitment of the Catholic Church to the people of Red Lake. For people not knowing if they would ever have a Catholic Church again, the church is a symbol of hope and comfort.

This year, in memory of Marvin and Marilyn Reis's years of commitment to the missions of Wounded Knee and St Mary's in Red Lake, Diane and Dan Sullivan plan to make another visit this fall before the start of the new school year to Red Lake. The needs of the mission for our drive are again diapers and wipes; and for the children at the school, the gummy multi vitamins with omega 3 and school supply boxes are really appreciated.

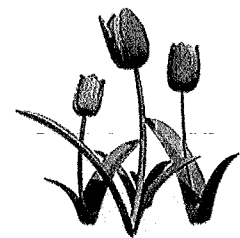
