Approved Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order by Chair Frank Kisley at 8:10 pm.

Minutes of October 16, 2025, Pastoral Council Meeting: Ruth made a motion, Patty seconded the motion and the Minutes of the October 16, 2025, Pastoral Council Meeting were approved.

Old Business:

The dumpster for the church has officially changed over to Red Can Services. The current dumpster is bigger and cheaper than the previous one from Jendro.

Frank was quoted by Sim Sound & Video five options for various technology updates in either the sanctuary or the parish hall. These options were shared with council members with nothing being decided upon. Sam Taets will be contacting Frank Arciniega to see if he would do any of the various updates previously listed, and quotes if so.

The lights around the church and the courtyard will be on the same timer. The timer will turn the lights on at dusk and off at dawn. The parking lot lights timer will remain the same.

Sam informed the council that she needs a layout of the church before she can create an evacuation/shelter plan proposal. Annette is looking into this.

First Aid and CPR training is open to the ushers during the day and the evening with classes in December.

Frank spoke with Rich Brumm about getting our church interior, design painted. Rich was going to check with Jeff Clark and get details about the company as his church in Roseville had recently been painted.

Father Dery is pleased with his house cleaner. Patty reported that the rectory may be needing a new vacuum in the near future.

A new money lock box has been installed in the short hallway between the sacristy and the main office for budget and offertory money. It operates very similarly to a night drop at a bank. Annette and Jill have keys to open it.

Father Dery Report:

Final feedback from Journey in Faith is to be submitted on the 21st of this month.

Tuesday, December 23, following Mass until noon, Father has proposed having a prayer retreat with the Finance and Pastoral Councils, along with the St. Isidore staff..

It was decided to forgo a council meeting in December with the busyness of the holidays.
