

**Sacred Heart Pastoral Council**  
**January 15, 2026**  
**Approved Meeting Minutes**

The meeting was called to order by Chair Frank Kisley at 8:02 pm.

**Attendance:** Father Dery, Frank Kisley, Patty Kisley, Judy Mayer, Sara Ramker, Ruth DeGross, Sam Taets and Guest Annette Uker and Frank Fox, from Fox Auction Company.

**Minutes of November 20th, 2025 Pastoral Council Meeting:** Ruth made a motion, Patty seconded the motion and the Minutes of the November 20th, 2025 Pastoral Council Meeting were approved.

**Old Business:**

Floyd County farm sale update can be found in the January 15th finance council minutes. Frank reminded members of the councils that they have the right to refuse any bids at any price.

Home Trust was decided upon to provide the refreshments to those attending the land auction as they hold the church's main checking account.

CPR and First Aid training is being put in the bulletin, offering it to the ushers and public at no cost.

Frank anticipates Al Demaris will be sending a bill for the lights that were put in the courtyard and all around the church. Frank will be contacting Frank Arciniega about getting cameras updated in sanctuary and/or parish hall.

After multiple conversations, it was decided upon that the caulk needed to be replaced on the baptismal font. Cambria recommended a specific caulk which Al Winters will be applying to see if it fixes the leak.

**New Business:**

Frank reported that in order to livestream mass on Youtube the church needs a new computer. The council was informed that Father Dery's mic is in need of getting replaced. The council unanimously approved the replacement of Father Dery's mic.

At this time, all the staff at the church has Journey in Faith training on Tuesdays to help prepare for the upcoming transitions. From March till June the new priests and mass

schedules will be determined. In July, new mass schedules will be implemented and further planning and assessment of the new pastorate will take place.

Frank contacted Ron Wiley concerning painting the interior of the church and was informed that they are booked out until 2028. However, because we are close in proximity to the painting company, they should be able to fit us in sooner. The company will be contacting Frank when they have an opening.

The Elevator Banquet is coming up the first week in March and there is a need church wide for help in making this a successful event. A committee would be beneficial for planning out all the details. Jan Adams and Helen Gerdes have had a great part in organizing and planning previous banquets with hopes they will continue in the upcoming banquets.
