

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

What is CGS?

The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) is a method for the religious formation of children rooted in the Bible, the liturgy of the church, and the educational principles of Maria Montessori.

In CGS, children gather in the atrium, a room specifically prepared as a place of prayer and encounter with God through a variety of hands on materials and presentations. The children work with materials of their own choice and at their own pace. They experience a combination of freedom and self-discipline in a place designed to meet their developmental and spiritual needs.

LEVEL 1 (AGE 3-KINDERGARTEN)

The young child is particularly capable of receiving and enjoying the most essential elements of our faith—the announcement of God's love especially experienced through Jesus, the Good Shepherd, who died and is risen.

Materials on the life of Jesus Christ and his teachings help to make the mystery of God concrete for the child.

Selected parables help children understand the Kingdom of God.

Working with the model altar allows the child to become familiar with articles of mass and inspires reverence for the Blessed Sacrament.
