From the Desk of Deacon Chris....

<u> "THE JOY OF THE GOSPEL" – </u> POPE FRANCIS' APOSTOLIC **EXHORTATION**

On the eve of Pope Francis' first visit to the United States, I turned to the Holy Father's Apostolic Exhortation, "The Joy of the Gospel," and found that it emphasizes the spirit of evangelization in our Church. I found a couple of quotations from Pope Francis that I want to share with you. Pope Francis tells us, "Before all else, the Gospel invites us to respond to the God of love who saves us, to see God in others, and to go forth from ourselves to seek the good of others." Let's just break that quotation down, and reflect on it.

"The Gospel invites us to respond to the God of love who saves us." – We are all called to a loving relationship with God. God's unconditional love is always with us because God is love. The challenge is for us to respond to God's love in ways that will lead us to eternal salvation. How we respond to God's love matters.

"To see God in others." – Do you see God in others? Or, do you judge others based on their appearance, or their social status, or their race? Do you see all people as beloved children of God? Do you love others as God loves them?

"To go forth from ourselves to seek the good of others." – Jesus told us the last shall be first, and the first among you will be the servant of all. Are we able to place the needs of others ahead of our own needs? Can we all remember times when we have sought the good of others with no expectation of any gain or reward for ourselves? Isn't it true that the love that grows in our hearts when we have served others, is all the reward we need?

Our Holy Father is a living example of the new evangelization, a living example of the joy of the Gospel among us. Let us all pray for him, and the success of his first visit to our country. I will close with another quote from Pope Francis for all of us to reflect upon: "Instead of imposing new obligations, Christians should appear as people who wish to share their joy, who point to a horizon of beauty and who invite others to a delicious banquet."
